20 The Attorney General of the State of California by this information hereby accuses
21 Defendant SIRON CROSKEY of the following offenses:

22 **COUNT ONE**

23 **THEFT**

24 (PENAL CODE SECTION 484(a))

25 On or about August 17, 2022, in the County of Alameda, the crime of THEFT, in violation
26 of Penal Code section 484(a), a misdemeanor, was committed by SIRON CROSKEY, who did
27 willfully and unlawfully take personal property from [REDACTED] to wit: \$675.
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COUNT TWO
SECOND DEGREE ROBBERY
(PENAL CODE SECTION 211/212.5(c))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected together in its commission with the charge set forth in Count 1, complainant further complains and says: On or about August 17, 2022, in the County of Alameda, the crime of SECOND DEGREE ROBBERY, in violation of Penal Code section 211/212.5(c), a felony, was committed by SIRRON CROSKEY, who did willfully, unlawfully, and by means of force or fear take personal property from the person, possession, and immediate presence of [REDACTED] to wit: \$675.

IT IS FURTHER ALLEGED, as to Count 2 that, in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the said defendant, SIRRON CROSKEY, personally used a firearm, to wit: a handgun, within the meaning of Penal Code Sections 12022.5(a) and 1203.06(a)(1).

COUNT THREE
THEFT
(PENAL CODE SECTION 484(a))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of crimes and offenses as the charge set forth in Count 1, complainant further complains and says: On or about August 17, 2022, in the County of Santa Clara, the crime of THEFT, in violation of Penal Code section 484(a), a misdemeanor, was committed by SIRRON CROSKEY, who did willfully and unlawfully take personal property from of [REDACTED] to wit: \$100.

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COUNT SIX
SECOND DEGREE ROBBERY
(PENAL CODE SECTION 211/212.5(c))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected together in its commission with the charge set forth in Count 5, complainant further complains and says: On or about August 17, 2022, in the county of Santa Clara, the crime of SECOND DEGREE ROBBERY, in violation of Penal Code section 211/212.5(c), a felony, was committed by SIRRON CROSKEY, who did willfully, unlawfully, and by means of force or fear take personal property from the person, possession, and immediate presence of [REDACTED] to wit: \$500 and a wallet.

IT IS FURTHER ALLEGED, as to Count 6 that, in the commission and attempted commission of the above offense, the said defendant, SIRRON CROSKEY, personally used a firearm, to wit: a handgun, within the meaning of Penal Code Sections 12022.5(a) and 1203.06(a)(1).

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COUNT SEVEN
CRIMINAL THREATS
(PENAL CODE SECTION 422)

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected together in its commission with the charges set forth in Counts 5 and 6, complainant further complains and says: On or about August 17, 2022, in the county of Santa Clara, the crime of MAKING CRIMINAL THREATS, in violation of Penal Code section 422, a felony, was committed by SIRRON CROSKEY, who did willfully and unlawfully threaten [REDACTED] with the specific intent to make a threat that on its face and under the circumstances was so unequivocally, unconditionally, immediately, and specifically conveyed, with a gravity of

1 purpose and an immediate prospect of execution, that it caused [REDACTED] to be in sustained fear
2 for his own safety.

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4 IT IS FURTHER ALLEGED, as to Count 7 that, in the commission and attempted commission of
5 the above offense, the said defendant, SIRRON CROSKEY, personally used a firearm, to wit: a
6 handgun, within the meaning of Penal Code Sections 12022.5(a) and 1203.06(a)(1).
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9 **COUNT EIGHT**
10 **DISPLAYING FALSE LICENSE PLATE**
11 **(VEHICLE CODE SECTION 4463(a)(1))**

12 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected
13 together in its commission with the charges set forth in Counts 5, 6, and 7, complainant further
14 complains and says: On or about August 17, 2022, in the county of Santa Clara, the crime of
15 DISPLAYING A FALSE LICENSE PLATE, in violation of Vehicle Code section 4463(a)(1), a
16 felony, was committed by SIRRON CROSKEY, who did willfully and unlawfully drive a Ford
17 Fusion displaying California license plate 8WTS288, when that license plate was the property of
18 the Tracy Mazda Dealership and registered to a Chevrolet Trail Blazer.

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20 **COUNT NINE**
21 **GRAND THEFT**
22 **(PENAL CODE SECTION 487(a))**

23 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of
24 crimes and offenses as the charges set forth in Counts 1, 3 and 5, complainant further complains
25 and says: On or about August 20, 2022, in the County of Alameda, the crime of GRAND THEFT,
26 in violation of Penal Code section 487(a), a felony, was committed by SIRRON CROSKEY, who
27 did willfully and unlawfully take personal property from another of a value exceeding Nine
28 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$950.00), to wit: \$1,880, a wallet and two iPhones from [REDACTED]

1 Fusion displaying California license plate 8WTS288, when that license plate was the property of
2 the Tracy Mazda Dealership and registered to a Chevrolet Trail Blazer.

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4 **COUNT EIGHTEEN**
5 **GRAND THEFT**
6 (PENAL CODE SECTION 487(a))

7 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of
8 crimes and offenses as the charges set forth in Counts 1, 3, 5, 9, 11 and 14, complainant further
9 complains and says: On or about August 26, 2022, in the County of Napa, the crime of GRAND
10 THEFT, in violation of Penal Code section 487(a), a felony, was committed by SIRRON
11 CROSKEY, who did willfully and unlawfully take personal property from another of a value
12 exceeding Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$950.00), to wit: \$2,000 from [REDACTED]

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14 **COUNT NINETEEN**
15 **SECOND DEGREE ROBBERY**
16 (PENAL CODE SECTION 211/212.5(c))

17 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected
18 together in its commission with the charge set forth in Count 18, complainant further complains
19 and says: On or about August 26, 2022, in the county of Napa, the crime of SECOND DEGREE
20 ROBBERY, in violation of Penal Code section 211/212.5(c), a felony, was committed by
21 SIRRON CROSKEY, who did willfully, unlawfully, and by means of force or fear take personal
22 property from the person, possession, and immediate presence of [REDACTED] to wit:
23 \$2,000.

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25 IT IS FURTHER ALLEGED, as to Count 19 that, in the commission and attempted commission
26 of the above offense, the said defendant, SIRRON CROSKEY, personally used a firearm, to wit:
27 a handgun, within the meaning of Penal Code Sections 12022.5(a) and 1203.06(a)(1).
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1 **VENUE**

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3 These charges are brought in Contra Costa County pursuant to Penal Code sections 786.5
4 and 781 in that the multiple offenses of theft involve the same defendant and substantially similar
5 activity in each affected county as part of Defendant's coordinated criminal scheme. Jurisdiction
6 also extends to all associated offenses connected together in their commission to the underlying
7 theft offenses.
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9 **STATUS ALLEGATION**

10 MANDATORY STATE PRISON INCARCERATION: The said defendant, SIRRON
11 CROSKEY, is hereby notified as to Counts 2, 4, 6, 10, 12, 15 and 19, that the above offenses are
12 violent felonies within the meaning of Penal Code section 667.5(c), and that pursuant to Penal
13 Code sections 1170(h)(3) and 1170(f), an executed sentence for the offense(s) herein charged
14 against said defendant shall be served in the state prison.
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16 MANDATORY STATE PRISON INCARCERATION: The said defendant, SIRRON
17 CROSKEY, is hereby notified as to Counts 2, 4, 6, 7, 10, 12, 15, 16 and 19, that the above
18 offense(s) are serious felonies within the meaning of Penal Code section 1192.7(c), and that
19 pursuant to Penal Code sections 1170(h)(3) and 1170(f), an executed sentence for the offense(s)
20 herein charged against said defendant shall be served in the state prison.
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22 NOTE: Conviction of these offenses, as to Counts 2, 4, 6 - 21, will require the said defendant,
23 SIRRON CROSKEY, to provide specimens and samples pursuant to Penal Code section 296.
24 Willful refusal to provide the specimens and samples is a crime. Willful refusal to provide
25 specimens and samples is a crime.
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1 NOTE: As to Counts 2, 4, 6, 7, 10, 12, 15, 16 and 19, and the enhancement pursuant to Penal
2 Code 12022.5 alleged with said counts, committed by the defendant, SIRRON CROSKEY, it is
3 further alleged, pursuant to California Rules of Court 4.421(a)(1), that the crime involved threat
4 of great bodily harm, disclosing a high degree of cruelty, viciousness, or callousness.
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6 NOTE: As to Counts 2, 4, 6, 7, 10, 12, 15, 16 and 19, and the enhancement pursuant to Penal
7 Code 12022.5 alleged with said counts, committed by the defendant, SIRRON CROSKEY, it is
8 further alleged, pursuant to California Rules of Court 4.421(a)(2), that the defendant was armed
9 with or used a weapon at the time of the commission of the crime.
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11 NOTE: As to Counts 2, 4, 6, 10, 12, 15 and 19, and the enhancement pursuant to Penal Code
12 12022.5 alleged with said counts, committed by the defendant, SIRRON CROSKEY, it is further
13 alleged, pursuant to California Rules of Court 4.421(a)(8), that the manner in which the crime
14 was carried out indicates planning sophistication, or professionalism.
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16 NOTE: As to Counts 2, 4, 6, 10, 12, 15 and 19, and the enhancement pursuant to Penal Code
17 12022.5 alleged with said counts, committed by the defendant, SIRRON CROSKEY, it is further
18 alleged, pursuant to California Rules of Court 4.421(b)(1), that the defendant has engaged in
19 violent conduct that indicates a serious danger to society.
