**FELONY COMPLAINT AND DECLARATION IN SUPPORT OF ARREST; ARREST WARRANT**

Return: April 30, 2026

The undersigned is informed and believes that:

**COUNT 1**

**POSSESSION FOR SALE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE HS 11351**

On or about April 24, 2026, MICHAEL EDWARD FLORES did unlawfully possess for sale a controlled substance, to wit, fentanyl, in violation of Health and Safety Code section 11351, a felony.

1 It is further alleged that the weight of the substance containing fentanyl exceeded 10  
2 kilograms, within the meaning of Health and Safety Code section 11370.4(c)(1)(F).

3 **SPEC ALLEG-PERSONALLY ARMED/FIREARM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES**

4 It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offenses  
5 MICHAEL EDWARD FLORES was personally armed with a firearm within the meaning of  
6 Penal Code section 12022(c).

7 **COUNT 2**

8 **SALE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE HS 11352(A)**

9 On or about April 24, 2026, MICHAEL EDWARD FLORES did sell, furnish, and give  
10 away a controlled substance, to wit, fentanyl, in violation of Health and Safety Code section  
11 11352(a), a felony.

12 **SPEC ALLEG-PERSONALLY ARMED/FIREARM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES**

13 It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offenses  
14 MICHAEL EDWARD FLORES was personally armed with a firearm within the meaning of  
15 Penal Code section 12022(c).

16 **COUNT 3**

17 **POSSESSION FOR SALE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE HS 11351**

18 On or about April 24, 2026, MICHAEL EDWARD FLORES did unlawfully possess for  
19 sale a controlled substance, to wit, cocaine, in violation of Health and Safety Code section 11351,  
20 a felony.

21 It is further alleged that the substance containing cocaine in the above charged offense  
22 exceeded one kilogram by weight within the meaning of Health and Safety Code section  
23 11370.4(a)(1)(A).

24 **SPEC ALLEG-PERSONALLY ARMED/FIREARM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES**

25 It is further alleged that in the commission and attempted commission of the above offenses  
26 MICHAEL EDWARD FLORES was personally armed with a firearm within the meaning of  
27 Penal Code section 12022(c).

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**CIRCUMSTANCES IN AGGRAVATION**

It is further alleged as to defendant MICHAEL EDWARD FLORES as to Counts 1-3, pursuant to Penal Code Section 1170(b)(2) and within the meaning of California Rules of Court Rule 4.421, that there exist circumstances in aggravation, including the following factors:

1. The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning, sophistication, or professionalism (Rule 4.421(a)(8)); and
2. The crime involved a large quantity of contraband (Rule 4.421(a)(10))

**REQUEST FOR DISCOVERY**

Pursuant to Penal Code section 1054.5, subdivision (b), the People informally request that defense counsel provide discovery to the People as required by Penal Code section 1054.3.

**NOTICE TO ATTORNEY**

Any materials accompanying this complaint or provided by the People in this case may contain information about witnesses. Such information is subject to Penal Code section 1054.2, which provides, "No attorney may disclose or permit to be disclosed to a defendant the address or telephone number of a victim or witness whose name is disclosed to the attorney pursuant to subdivision (a) of section 1054.1 unless specifically permitted to do so by the court after a hearing and a showing of good cause."

**DECLARATION**

Further, attached and incorporated herein are official reports, documents, and/or a declaration of a law enforcement agency, which the undersigned believes establish probable cause for the arrest of Defendant Michael Edward FLORES for the above-listed crimes. Wherefore, a warrant of arrest is requested for said defendant.

I DECLARE UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY THAT THE FOREGOING IS TRUE AND CORRECT AND THAT THIS COMPLAINT CONSISTS OF THREE (3) COUNT.


