SPECIAL ALLEGATION 1

As to Counts 1 through 26, it is further alleged that in the commission of the above offenses, the said Defendants DIEGO SOLER, JESUS BARON, EDNA RICO, LEOBARDO LEONY, MONICA JIMENEZ MORENO, and ELKIN RUIZ RICO, violated PENAL CODE SECTION 186.11(a)(3), in that the offenses set forth in Counts 1 through 26 are related felonies, a material element of which is fraud and embezzlement, which involves a pattern of related felony conduct, and the pattern of related felony conduct involves the taking of more than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000).

NOTICE: A finding of this special allegation excludes a defendant from a sentence of imprisonment in the county jail pursuant to Penal Code section 1170, subdivision (h).

SPECIAL ALLEGATION 2
