On or about and between January 1, 2017 and September 27, 2019, at and in the County of Solano in the State of California, defendant IQBAL SINGH RANDHAWA did commit a felony, namely FAILURE TO PROVIDE TRAVEL SERVICES OR RETURN MONEYS, a violation of section 17550.14(a)(1) of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California, in that said defendant did unlawfully, being a "Seller of Travel," fail to promptly return to a passenger all moneys paid for services not performed and goods not delivered in accordance with a contract.

It is further alleged that the above "Seller of Travel" obtained \$2350.00 and more in a consecutive 12-month period from all persons and \$950.00 and more from one person in a 12 month period.

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COUNT 21

ENCUMBERING MONEY FROM TRUST ACCOUNT

Business & Professions Code § 17550.15(c)

On or about and between January 1, 2017 and September 27, 2019, at and in the County of Solano in the State of California, defendant IQBAL SINGH RANDHAWA did commit a felony, namely ENCUMBERING MONEY FROM TRUST ACCOUNT, a violation of section 17550.15(c) of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California, in that said defendant did unlawfully, being a "Seller of Travel," fail to deposit payments for travel services into a trust ACCOUNT, encumbered the corpus of the trust ACCOUNT and withdrew money therefrom.

It is further alleged that the above "Seller of Travel" obtained \$2350.00 and more in a consecutive 12-month period from all persons and \$950.00 and more from one person in a 12-month period.

COUNT 22

SPEC ALLEGATION – AGGRAVATED WHITE COLLAR CRIME

Penal Code § 186.11(a)

It is further alleged as to Count 1-19, that the offenses set forth in Counts 1 through 19 are related felonies, a material element of which is fraud and embezzlement, which involve a pattern of related felony conduct, and the pattern of related felony conduct involves the taking of more than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000), to wit: \$147,617.14.

COUNT 23

OFFENSE WHILE ON BAIL ENHANCEMENT CPC § 12022.1

It is further alleged as to COUNTS 18 and 19, that at the time of the commission of the above offense, the defendant was released from custody on bail or Own Recognizance in this case within the meaning of Penal Code section 12022.1.
