The Attorney General of the State of California accuses the above-named Defendants of the following offenses, which are connected to each other in their commission:

COUNT 1

On or about and between April 1, 2018 through March 31, 2022, in the Counties of Los Angeles, Orange, San Diego, Riverside, Alameda, Santa Clara, San Francisco, and Contra Costa, the crime of GRAND THEFT in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 487(a), a Felony, was committed by Defendants US FRAMING WEST, INC and THOMAS GREGORY ENGLISH, who did unlawfully take money and property of a value exceeding Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$950), to wit, Two Million Five Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Nine Dollars and Sixty-Eight Cents (\$2,577,289.68) from the State of California.

COUNT 2

On or about and between April 1, 2018 through March 31, 2022, in the Counties of Los Angeles, Orange, San Diego, Riverside, Alameda, Santa Clara, San Francisco, and Contra Costa, the crime of WILLFUL FAILURE TO PAY TAX, in violation of UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE CODE Section 2117.5 a Felony, was committed by Defendants US FRAMING WEST, INC and THOMAS GREGORY ENGLISH, who did willfully fail to collect and truthfully account for and pay over any tax or amount required to be withheld within the time required by law.

COUNT 3

On or about and between April 1, 2018 through March 31, 2022, in the Counties of Los Angeles, Orange, San Diego, Riverside, Alameda, Santa Clara, San Francisco, and Contra Costa, the crime of WILLFUL FAILURE TO PAY TAX, in violation of UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE CODE Section 2118.5 a Felony, was committed by Defendants US FRAMING WEST, INC and THOMAS GREGORY ENGLISH, who did willfully fail to collect and truthfully account for and pay over any tax or amount required to be withheld within the time required by law.

SPECIAL ALLEGATION

AGGRAVATED WHITE COLLAR CRIME - LOSS > \$500,000

Furthermore, the offenses alleged in Counts 1 – 22 are related felonies, a material element of which is fraud and embezzlement, which involved a pattern of related felony conduct, and the pattern of related felony conduct involved the taking of, and resulted in the loss by the State of California, Conrado Alavez-Aquino, Silvano Alvarez-Aquino, Eleazar Andes, Gumercindo Andes-Morales, Sergio Arroyo-Medina, Ramon Avilez, Carlos Bandera, Ada Bran, Esvin Bravo, Eliseo Cruz, Juan Carlos Dedios Perez, Enrique Garcia, Antonio Garcia-Aquino, Lucas Garcia-Sancehz, Fidel Miralrio, Ezequiel Moreno, Javier Murgia, Jeronimo Trujilio, and Israel Valdez, of more than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000), to wit, a total loss of Two Million, Six Hundred Eighteen Thousand, Six Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars and Seventy-Nine Cents (\$2,618,624.89) thus subjecting the Defendants US FRAMING WEST, INC and THOMAS GREGORY ENGLISH to the additional punishment provided for in Penal Code section 186.11(a)(2).

SPECIAL ALLEGATION

EXCESSIVE LOSS OVER \$100,000

It is further alleged that the offenses alleged in Counts 1-22 constitute theft of over \$100,000, within the meaning of Penal Code section 1203.045(a).
