COUNT 1 - ORGANIZED RETAIL THEFT

NOTE: Jurisdiction for this offense exists in this court when brought by the Attorney General pursuant to Penal Code section 786.5.

COUNT 25 - GRANDTHEFT

On or about March 30, 2024, in the County of San Diego, the crime of GRAND THEFT, a violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 487(a), a Felony, was committed by defendants RODNEY ALLEN FLYNT, SR., MICHAEL ANTHONY JONES, JR., CHRISTOPHER SHAWN PATE, and RYAN KEITH PATE, who did willfully and unlawfully take personal property of another of a value exceeding nine hundred fifty dollars (\$950), to wit: Merchandise from Banter by Piercing Pagoda – Mission Viejo.

NOTE: Jurisdiction for this offense exists in this court when brought by the Attorney General pursuant to Penal Code section 786.5.

COUNT 26 - SECOND DEGREE COMMERCIAL BURGLARY

On or about March 30, 2024, in the County of Orange, the crime of SECOND DEGREE COMMERCIAL BURGLARY, a violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 459, a Felony, was committed by defendants RODNEY ALLEN FLYNT, SR., MICHAEL ANTHONY JONES, JR., CHRISTOPHER SHAWN PATE, and RYAN KEITH PATE who did enter a commercial building occupied by Banter by Piercing Pagoda, located at Shops At Mission Viejo, #104, Mission Viejo, CA, with the intent to commit larceny and any felony.

NOTE: Jurisdiction for this offense exists in this court when brought by the Attorney General pursuant to Penal Code section 786.5.

COUNT 27 - GRAND THEFT

On or about April 16, 2024, in the County of Kern, the crime of SECOND DEGREE COMMERCIAL BURGLARY, a violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 459, a Felony, was committed by defendants RODNEY ALLEN FLYNT, SR., MICHAEL ANTHONY JONES, JR., CHRISTOPHER SHAWN PATE, and RYAN KEITH PATE who did enter a commercial building occupied by JC Penney, located at 2501 Ming Avenue, Bakersfield, CA, with the intent to commit larceny and any felony.

NOTE: Jurisdiction for this offense exists in this court when brought by the Attorney General pursuant to Penal Code section 786.5.

COUNT 29 - GRANDTHEFT

On or about May 8, 2024, in the County of San Diego, the crime of GRAND THEFT, a violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 487(a), a Felony, was committed by defendants RODNEY ALLEN FLYNT, SR., MICHAEL ANTHONY JONES, JR., CHRISTOPHER SHAWN PATE, and RYAN KEITH PATE, who did willfully and unlawfully take personal property of another of a value exceeding nine hundred fifty dollars (\$950), to wit: Merchandise from JC Penney

- National City.

NOTE: Jurisdiction for this offense exists in this court when brought by the Attorney General pursuant to Penal Code section 786.5.

COUNT 30 - SECOND DEGREE COMMERCIAL BURGLARY

On or about May 8, 2024, in the County of San Diego, the crime of SECOND DEGREE COMMERCIAL BURGLARY, a violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 459, a Felony, was committed by defendants RODNEY ALLEN FLYNT, SR., MICHAEL ANTHONY JONES, JR., CHRISTOPHER SHAWN PATE, and RYAN KEITH PATE who did enter a commercial building occupied by JC Penney, located at 3040 Plaza Bonita Rd, National City, CA 91950, with the intent to commit larceny and any felony.

NOTE: Jurisdiction for this offense exists in this court when brought by the Attorney General pursuant to Penal Code section 786.5.

CIRCUMSTANCES IN AGGRAVATION (CALIFORNIA RULE OF COURT 4.421; PENAL CODE SECTION 1170(B)(2))

It is further alleged as to all charges, that RODNEY ALLEN FLYNT, SR., MICHAEL ANTHONY JONES, JR., CHRISTOPHER SHAWN PATE, and RYAN KEITH PATE per PENAL CODE SECTION 1170(b)(2) and within the meaning of Rule 4.421 of the California Rules of Court, that there exist circumstances in aggravation including the following factors:

- 1. The defendant(s) induced others to participate in the commission of the crime or occupied a position of leadership or dominance of other participants in its commission (4.421(a)(4));
- 2. The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning, sophistication, or professionalism (4.421(a)(8));
- 3. The defendant(s) took advantage of a position of trust or confidence to commit the offense (4.421(a)(11)).

SPECIAL ALLEGATION

Furthermore, as to Counts 1, 4 through 8, 10, 12, 13, and 22 through 30, the offenses alleged are related felonies, a material element of which is fraud and embezzlement, which involved a pattern of related felony conduct, and the pattern of related felony conduct involved the taking of, and resulted in the loss by Banter by Piercing Pagoda, Kay Jewelers, Zales Jewelers, Karrada Jewelry Stores, Princess Jewelry, Marc Jacob, and JC Penney of, more than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000), thus subjecting defendants RODNEY ALLEN FLYNT, SR., MICHAEL ANTHONY JONES, JR., CHRISTOPHER SHAWN PATE, and RYAN KEITH PATE to the additional punishment provided for in Penal Code section 186.11(a)(2).

NOTICE: Prison custody time is to be served in state prison if the enhancement pursuant to Penal Code section 186.11 is imposed as part of the sentence for the above offense, within the meaning of Penal Code section 1170(h)(3).
