~~[PROPOSED]~~ **ADMINISTRATIVE STAY
ORDER**

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For the reasons stated at the September 10, 2026 conference, including to preserve the status quo, provide the Court time to address the merits of Plaintiffs' preliminary injunction motion, and accommodate Defendants' requested additional time for briefing, the Court hereby issues the following administrative stay.

From the time of this order through October 2, 2026, the deadlines in all "management directed reassignment" ("MDR") letters, and any other notice or directive of reassignment or relocation pursuant to the challenged Reorganization Plan, issued to employees in the U.S. Department of Agriculture ("USDA") components listed below, including any deadlines requiring employees to report to new locations or to accept or decline reassignments or relocations, are stayed. Defendants shall not take any action to implement, carry out, effectuate, or enforce those deadlines, including proceeding with any termination, separation, or other disciplinary proceeding against an employee, or placing an employee on Absent Without Leave status, based on the employee's decision to decline reassignment, not to respond to a notice of reassignment, or not to relocate.

This administrative stay applies only to the following USDA components: the Food and Nutrition Administration; Research, Education, and Economics mission area; Forest Service; Foreign Agricultural Service; Rural Development mission area; Farm Production and Conservation mission area; Office of the General Counsel; and Office of the Assistant Secretary for Civil Rights.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, this administrative stay does not apply to deadlines pertaining to the relocation or reassignment of USDA employees currently located within the National Capital Region¹ to other local offices or locations also located within the National Capital Region.
