9 victim of the above offenses, [REDACTED] (age 85 years), was particularly vulnerable, within the meaning
10 of California Rules of Court Rule 4.421(a)(3).

11 **California Rules of Court § 4.421(a)(11) – Position of Trust:** It is further alleged that the
12 defendant took advantage of a position of trust or confidence to commit the offenses, within the
13 meaning of California Rules of Court Rule 4.421(a)(11).

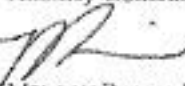
14 **Penal Code § 1170.85(b) – Elderly and Dependent Victim:** It is further alleged, pursuant
15 to California Penal Code section 1170.85(b) that the victim of the above offenses, [REDACTED], was
