For a further and separate cause of action, being a different offense from, but connected in its commission with the charge set forth in Count One hereof, complainant further complains and says:

That on or about April 23,2002, defendant KARI LYNN DOHN did commit a FELONY, rlamely, a violation of Section 6200 of the Government Code, ALTERATION OF GOVERNMENT RECORDS, in that she was an officer having custody of a record, map, book, or paper filed or deposited in a public office, or placed in the defendant's hands and, as to the whole or part thereof, did steal, remove, secrete, destroy, mutilate, deface, alter or falsify said document.

COUNT THREE

For a further and separate cause of action, being a different offense from, but connected in its commission with the charges set forth in Counts One and Two hereof, complainant complains and says:

That on or about April 25,2002, defendant KARI LYNN DOHN did commit a FELONY, damely, a violation of Section 134 of the Penal Code, PREPARING FALSE DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE, in that she did unlawfully prepare a false or ante-dated book, paper, record, instrument in writing, or other matter and thing, with intent to produce it, or allow it to be produced for a fraudulent or deceitful purpose, as genuine or true, upon a trial, proceeding, or inquiry whatever, authorized by law.

COUNT FOUR

For a further and separate cause of action, being a different offense from, but connected in its commission with the charges set forth in Counts One through Three hereof, complainant complains and says:

That on or about April 25,2002, defendant KARI LYNN DOHN did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 6200 of the Government Code, ALTERATION OF GOVERNMENT RECORDS, in that she was an officer having custody of a record, map, book, or paper filed or deposited in a public office, or placed in the defendant's hands and, as to the whole or part thereof, did steal, remove, secrete, destroy, mutilate, deface, alter or falsify said document.

COUNT FIVE

For a further and separate cause of action, being a different offense from, but connected in its commission with the charges set forth in Counts One through Four hereof, complainant complains and says:


