16	Becerra, and Defendant Maria Salazar (Defendant Salazar), appearing through her attorney,		
17.	Samuel J. Smith, having stipulated and consented to the entry of this Judgment without the taking		
18	of proof and without trial or adjudication of any fact or law herein, without this Judgment		
19	constituting evidence of or an admission by Defer		
20	alleged in the Complaint on file, and without Defe	endant Salazar admitting any liability regarding	
21	allegations of violations that occurred prior to entry of this Judgment, and the Court having		
22	considered the matter and good cause appearing:		
23	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:		
24	1. This Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter hereof and the parties hereto.		
25	2. Venue is proper in this Court.		
26	3. Nothing in this Judgment alters the requirements of federal or state law to the		
27	extent they offer greater protection to consumers.		
28	4. The Court shall retain continuing jurisdiction for the purpose of enabling any party

to the Judgment to apply to the Court at any time for such further orders and directions as may be				
necessary or appropriate for the construction or the carrying out of this Judgment, for the				
modification of any of the injunctive provisions hereof, for enforcement of compliance herewith, o				
for the punishment of violations hereof, if any.				

- 5. Defendant Salazar shall pay penalties of \$10,800 (ten thousand and eight hundred) to Plaintiff under Business and Professions Code section 17206. Payment shall be made at the rate of \$1,200 (one thousand and two hundred) per year for nine (9) years as follows:
  - a. Defendant Salazar shall pay the first installment of \$1,200 on or before July 1, 2019. The eight remaining installment payments of \$1,200 are due on or before July 1<sup>st</sup> of each successive year until 2027.
  - b. The outstanding balance becomes immediately due and payable upon Defendant Salazar's death or if any installment payment is more than thirty (30) days late. The penalties do not accrue interest unless and until Defendant Salazar is more than thirty (30) days late with her installment payment. If any payment is more than thirty (30) days late, the People may collect the remaining amount due, including interest at the statutory rate, running from the payment due date, as well as any costs associated with enforcement of the Judgment.
  - c. All penalty payments shall be made payable to the California Department of Justice and mailed to the Accounting Cashier, California Department of Justice, 1300 I Street, Sacramento, CA 9184. Each check shall bear on its face the Attorney General docket number of this case, LA2017507005. A photocopy of each check shall be sent at the same time to W. Richard Sintek, Office of the Attorney General, P.O. Box 85266, San Diego, CA 92186-5266.
- 6. This Judgment shall have res judicata effect and shall resolve any claim by the People against Defendant Salazar that the People might have asserted based on the acts or practices described in the First Amended Complaint in this action, to the extent such acts or practices occurred before the date of this Judgment and were known to the People as of the date of this Judgment.

1	7.	Defendant Salazar shall be and here	by is permanently enjoined and restrained,	
2	under California Business and Professions Code section 17203, from engaging in any of the			
3	following acts or practices:			
4	a. Requesting or receiving payment of any fee or consideration from a person for goods or			
5	services represented to recover or otherwise assist in the return of money or any other item of value			
6	paid for by, or promised to, that person in a previous telemarking transaction, until seven business			
7	days after that money or other item is delivered to that person; and			
8	b. Making or disseminating any false or misleading statements in connection with			
9	any telemarketing transaction.			
10	8.	In connection with this action, Defe	endant Salazar shall submit to an interview by	
11	the Attorney General's staff at such reasonable time as the staff requests upon reasonable notice.			
12	9. If any party to this Judgment brings an action to enforce any terms of this			
13	Judgment, the prevailing party shall be entitled to its reasonable costs of enforcement, including			
14	attorney fees and costs and expert witness fees.			
15	10.	Except as expressly provided in this	s Judgment, each party to this Judgment shall	
16	pay its own attorney fees, expert witness fees, and costs of litigation.			
17	IT IS	SO HEREBY ORDERED. The Cl	erk of the Court is directed to enter this	
18	Judgment for	thwith.
