




THIRD OVERT ACT

The Attorney General of the State of California, by this complaint further accuses that Defendant, JASON BEDELL TATE, on or about September 8, 2011 in the County of Placer, in the State of California, borrowed a truck.

On or about 9/8/2011, at and in the County of Santa Clara, in the State of California, Defendant JUSTIN JEREMY MAHLET did commit a felony, a violation of Vehicle Code

1 Section 2800.2(a) (Reckelssly Evading an Officer), in that Justin Mahlet did willfully and
2 unlawfully, while operating a motor vehicle and with intent to evade, flee, and otherwise attempt
3 to elude a pursuing officer's motor vehicle while all of the following conditions existed: the peace
4 officer's motor vehicle exhibited at least one lighted red lamp visible from the front and the
5 Defendant saw and reasonably should have seen the lamp, the peace officers motor vehicle was
6 sounding its siren as was reasonably necessary, the peace officers motor vehicle was distinctively
7 marked, the peace officers motor vehicle was operated by a peace officer.

Enhancement 1

10 It is further alleged, pursuant to Penal Code section 781 that the above offenses were
11 committed in part in Placer, Solano, Santa Clara, Alameda, and San Mateo, and Contra Costa
12 Counties.

13 All of which is contrary to the statue in such cases made and provided, and against the
14 peace and dignity of the People of the State of California.

18 It is further alleged, as to counts 1 through 18 that Justin Mahlet has suffered the following
