25 **PLEASE TAKE NOTICE**, pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21167.5,  
26 intervenor People of the State of California, *ex rel.* Attorney General Kamala D. Harris (People),  
27 intend to seek leave of court on January 25, 2012, at 8:30 a.m. in Department C-72, to intervene  
28 and file a petition for writ of mandate in intervention in this action under the provisions of the


1 California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Pub. Resources Code, § 21000 et seq.) and  
2 Government Code section 12606 against respondents San Diego Association of Governments and  
3 the San Diego Association of Governments Board of Directors. The People's petition challenges  
4 the adequacy of the Final Environmental Impact Report certified by the respondents for the 2050  
5 Regional Transportation Plan and Sustainable Communities Strategy (RTP/SCS) on October 28,  
6 2011.

7 The petition seeks a writ of mandate voiding the approval and certification of the  
8 RTP/SCS, directing respondents to suspend all activities pursuant to the RTP/SCS and directing  
9 respondents to fully comply with the requirements of CEQA with respect to the RTP/SCS. The  
10 petition also seeks a related stay of actions to carry out the RTP/SCS and requests an award of  
11 costs and fees.
