

The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

PROHIBITS INVOLUNTARY SERVITUDE AS A PUNISHMENT FOR CRIME.

INITIATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT. Amends California Constitution to prohibit involuntary servitude in all instances, by removing the current exception that allows involuntary servitude to punish crime. For example, requiring inmates to work without pay would not be permitted. Summary of estimate by Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance of fiscal impact on state and local governments: **Fiscal effects on state and local government could range from no effect to a significant increase in state and local costs, depending on how the measure is interpreted and implemented.** (21-0003.)
