The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

BALLOT-MEASURE SUMMARIES. INITIATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT
AND STATUTE. Transfers the elected Attorney General's constitutional and statutory
authority to write summaries of statewide ballot measures for use in election materials and for
collecting qualifying signatures to the Legislative Analyst, who is appointed by a joint committee
of the Legislature. Eliminates existing requirement that summaries describe a measure's chief
purpose and points; instead, requires summaries describe the primary changes in law. Requires
advisory committee to recommend changes to summaries for clarity. Requires Legislative
Analyst to post on website documents it receives relating to ballot measures. Summary of
estimate by Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance of fiscal impact on state and local
governments: Depending on how the measure were implemented, there could be minor

state savings or costs. (21-0024A1.)
