The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

CONSTITUTIONAL REQUIREMENTS ON PUBLIC EDUCATION. INITIATIVE
CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT. Amends California Constitution to require the state
and its school districts to "provide a high-quality public education to all public school students,"
the requirements of which are not defined and will depend on how the measure is implemented
by the Legislature, state agencies, and public schools (including charter schools), and interpreted
by court decisions. Summary of estimate by Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance of
fiscal impact on state and local governments: No direct fiscal effects on the state or public
schools because the measure does not require any change to current policies or programs.
Depending on how the measure is legally interpreted by the courts and implemented by the
state and public schools, there could be fiscal effects that are unknown and highly
