

The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

**PROHIBITS GOVERNMENT ENTITIES FROM RESTRICTING BOYCOTTS AND
OTHER ACTIVITIES SUPPORTING PALESTINIAN RIGHTS OR OPPOSING**

ISRAEL’S ACTIONS. INITIATIVE STATUTE. Prohibits policies by state and local governments and agencies, California State University, and University of California that: (1) restrict engagement in activities—including boycotts, divestments, and sanctions—that express support for Palestinian rights or opposition to Israel’s actions (“BDS activities”); or (2) condition eligibility for contracts, grants, or other funding on agreement not to participate in BDS activities. Prohibits high schools, colleges, and universities from disciplining students for certain BDS activities. Prohibits public investment and retirement funds from adopting policies that restrict support of BDS activities. Summary of estimate by Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance of fiscal impact on state and local governments: **Net increase in state and local government costs, not likely to exceed the low millions of dollars annually, related to (1) developing new guidance and policies, (2) resolving alleged violations in the courts, and (3) responding to related public records requests.
