

The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

**ELIMINATES RIGHT OF LEGISLATORS WHO VOTED FOR TEMPORARY
CHANGES TO CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT MAPS IN RESPONSE TO TEXAS’
PARTISAN REDISTRICTING TO HOLD SPECIFIED OFFICES FOR 5–10 YEARS.**

INITIATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT. Prohibits legislators from holding specified offices after their current term if they voted in 2025 to ask voters to approve the temporary use of new congressional district maps in California until the Citizens Redistricting Commission adopts new maps in 2031, or if they vote for future redistricting measures.

Prohibition applies for 10 years to elective office, and five years to appointive office, legislative staff, and other specified offices, in California. Summary of estimate by Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance of fiscal impact on state and local governments: **No direct fiscal effect on state or local governments.** (25-0015.)
