

The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

RESTRICTS POLITICAL SPENDING BY HEALTH CARE UNIONS. INITIATIVE

STATUTE. Prohibits certain large health care unions from political spending over specified amounts regarding state or local ballot measures without following certain member consent requirements. Requires these unions to provide members annual notice describing prior-year political spending. Requirements apply only to unions, not employers. Imposes monetary penalties on unions as follows: (1) for violations of member consent requirements, the amount spent in violation of the requirements; and (2) for violations of member notice requirements, \$1,000 per member (e.g., a \$50,000,000 penalty if union does not provide notice to 50,000 members). Summary of estimate by Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance of fiscal impact on state and local governments: **Increased annual state costs, potentially in the range of millions of dollars, with some costs paid for by penalties created by the measure.**
