

The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

**CREATES CALIFORNIA STRATEGIC IMPLEMENTATION BOARD TO CHANGE
NUMEROUS ASPECTS OF STATE LAW AND GOVERNMENT. INITIATIVE**

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT. Creates California Strategic Implementation Board, comprised of state elected officials who each may receive up to \$26 million annually (paid from “Sovereign Transition Fund” with revenue generated from state’s “innovation sectors”).

Requires Board to propose a constitutional revision on April 2027 ballot that would, among other things: create constitutional rights to cognitive liberty, psilocybin, and paranoia; create social-services shelters called “Yvonne” sanctuaries; abolish the death penalty; allow non-California residents to cast advisory votes in California elections; provide personalized AI tutors to students; and prohibit tobacco sales to individuals born after January 1, 2010. Summary of estimate by Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance of fiscal impact on state and local governments: **It is the opinion of the Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance that the measure could result, if it went forward, in substantial net changes in state and local finances.**
