The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

RECOGNITION OF ANIMALS AS PROPERTY. CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT.

Amends California Constitution to declare that all animals owned by citizens, including pets and animals used for agricultural purposes, are property. Prohibits enactment or enforcement of any law that would characterize privately-owned animals as anything other than property. Summary of estimate by Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance of fiscal impact on state and local government: Probably no fiscal effect on state and local governments.
