

TO: ALL CALIFORNIA LAW ENFORCEMENT TELECOMMUNICATIONS (CLETS) USERS

The Department of Justice will be updating the California Restraining and Protective Order System (CARPOS) **effective July 1, 2025**. The update will allow agencies to enter the new Retail Crime Restraining Order forms created by the Judicial Council under AB 3209.

The following new restraining order type codes have been created:

- **RCO** Retail Crime Restraining Order—Criminal Form CR-164
- **RTO** Retail Crime Restraining Order Form RT-130

Below is the verbiage for the Contact Protected Persons Field (CON) field when "Y" or "N" is entered.

THE RESTRAINED PERSON MUST NOT ENTER OR BE PRESENT ON THE GROUNDS OR PARKING LOT OF THE PROTECTED RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT(S)

Programming changes will be required for agencies using local systems for data entry to accommodate the updates; however, the string format may be used as an alternative. For agencies utilizing LEAWEB, no programming changes will be necessary.
