**TO: ALL CALIFORNIA LAW ENFORCEMENT TELECOMMUNICATIONS (CLETS) USERS**

The California Department of Justice will be updating the California Restraining and Protective Order System (CARPOS) effective **January 1, 2026**. Senate Bill (SB) No. 899 (2023-2024 Reg. Sess.) amended Civil Code section 527.9, and added sections 527.11 and 527.12; amended Family Code sections 3044 and 6389; amended Penal Code sections 1524, 11108.2, 18120, 25555, 26379, 26540, 28100, 29810, 29830, 30342 and added section 18120.5 to, among other things, expand firearm relinquishment procedures. In response to SB 899, the Judicial Council of California (JCC) made changes to the Elder Abuse, Civil Harassment, Workplace Violence, School Violence, and Gun Violence Restraining Order forms, which require the following update to CARPOS.

The Restrained Firearm Group (RF1–RF9) fields will be enabled for the following order types:

- Temporary Restraining Order (Elder or Dependent Adult Abuse Prevention) (CLETS—TEA) form EA-110
- Elder or Dependent Adult Abuse Restraining Order After Hearing (CLETS—EAR) form EA-130
- Temporary Restraining Order (Civil Harassment Prevention) (CLETS—TCH) form CH-110
- Civil Harassment Restraining Order After Hearing (CLETS—CHO) form CH-130
- Temporary Restraining Order (Workplace Violence Prevention) (CLETS—TWH) form WV-110
- Workplace Violence Restraining Order After Hearing (CLETS—WHO) form WV-130
- Temporary Restraining Order (Postsecondary School Violence Prevention) (CLETS—TSV) form SV-110
- Postsecondary School Violence Restraining Order After Hearing (CLETS—SVO) form SV-130
- Gun Violence Emergency Protective Order (CLETS—EGV) form EPO-002
- Gun Violence Restraining Order After Hearing on EPO-002 (CLETS—HGV) form GV-030
- Temporary Gun Violence Restraining Order (CLETS—TGV) form GV-110
- Gun Violence Restraining Order After Hearing or Consent to Gun Violence Restraining Order (CLETS—OGV) form GV-130

Agencies using local systems for data entry will need to make programming changes in order to accommodate the updates. However, agencies may use the string format as an alternative. For agencies utilizing LEAWEB, no programming changes will be necessary.
