NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF REGULATORY
ACTION

This action amends regulations to align with changes to the Child Abuse Neglect and Reporting Act (CANRA), directly impacting DOJ's administration of the Child Abuse Central Index (CACI). Effective January 1, 2012, Assembly Bill (AB) 717, Chapter 468, Statutes of 2011, amended the CANRA by limiting agencies authorized to submit CACI reports to county child welfare and probation departments. The chaptered legislation also limited the abuse determination maintained in the CACI to substantiated reports and required the removal of any person listed in the CACI who has reached 100 years of age. Effective January 1, 2013, AB 1707, Chapter 848, Statutes of 2012, further amended the CANRA to require, ten years from the incident date resulting in the CACI listing, the removal of any person who was listed in the CACI before reaching 18 years old, if the person is listed only once with no subsequent listings.

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 4/1/2026.
