Report of No Longer Interested (NLI) Notification									
A licensing authority is required to notify the Department of Justice (DOJ) when the licensee's CCW license is revoked or denied so that DOJ can terminate the subsequent arrest notifications. (Cal. Pen. Code § 11105.2, subds. (d) & (f).) However, when a CCW license is denied or revoked based on a determination that the licensee is a disqualified person, agencies must delay submitting NLIs until after the deadline to request a hearing has lapsed for the applicant, or if the hearing was requested, until after the court's decision on the case is made. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 11, § 4430). Agencies must submit NLIs to the Bureau of Criminal Information and Analysis through the Applicant Justice Agency Connection System.
