21st Century No Bust Blackjack

There are 6 jackpot promotions offered in conjunction with the play of 21st Century No Bust Blackjack, called: 7-7-7 diamonds, 7-7-7 clubs, 7-7-7 hearts, 7-7-7 spades, 7 card 21 and 6-7-8 suited. The player/dealer's hand does not qualify for any of the jackpot bonuses.

1. 7-7-7 diamonds, clubs, hearts and spades:

- a. Each suit represents a different jackpot bonus.
- b. Qualifying hands:

A player must make a hand consisting of 3 seven's of the same suit. They must use their original 2 cards, no splitting, and hit one time with the third card matching suit and rank with the other two seven's.

c. Prize:

Each suit (Clubs, Diamonds, Hearts, and Spades) starts with a \$200 prize. If a player makes 7-7-7 suited, he/she will win the prize that corresponds to the suit of his/her 7-7-7 suited. At 10:00a.m., all the prizes increase by \$30, except for suits where a prize was awarded within the last 24 hours. After a prize is awarded, the prize for the winning suit is immediately reset at \$50.

- 2. 7 card 21:
 - a. Qualifying hands:

A player must make a hand totaling 21, using at least 7 cards and cannot contain a joker.

b. Prize:

The prize for the 7 card 21 jackpot will start at \$200. This amount increases by \$30 each day at 10:00 a.m. until it is awarded. When the 7 card 21 jackpot is hit the prize immediately resets at \$50.

3. 6-7-8 suited:

a. Qualifying hands:

A player must make a hand consisting of a six, seven and eight of the same suit. They must use their original two cards and hit once. No splitting. There is not a separate jackpot for each of the suits.

b. Prize:

The prize for the 6-7-8 suited jackpot will start at \$200. This amount increases by \$30 each day at 10:00 a.m. until it is awarded. When the 6-7-8 suited jackpot is hit the prize immediately resets at \$50.

III. Funding of Prizes:

Rancho's Club funds all Jackpot promotions from general funds. No separate collection or administrative fee is taken for these promotions.

Rancho's Club Casino

Aces Cracked Promotion Approval

The Aces Cracked Promotion features a fixed jackpot element attached to the game of Texas Hold'em. An opportunity to spin the wheel and win a prize is awarded to players participating in a jackpot game when a designated second hand is beaten by a better qualifying hand at the showdown. The promotional prize is funded by the Casino. A player that receives the qualifying losing hand will receive an opportunity to spin the wheel and when a prize in the form of a fixed cash amount or Match Play Coupons ranging in value from \$20 to \$200. In all instances, patrons will be provided with ample advance notice of posted jackpot prize for the game in which they are playing.

The player that makes the following specific advertised hand and loses to any other winning hand will be eligible to spin the wheel and win the Aces Cracked Promotional prize amount.

When the winning and losing hands are confirmed, the player with the qualifying losing hand shall win the prize of spinning a designated wheel that shall consist of thirty-six spots listing prizes in the form of cash, and Match Play Coupons. The spot that the pointer lands on will determine the prize amount or Match Play Coupon that the player will win. In all instances, patrons shall be provided with ample notice of the drawing times and of the posted prizes.

Losing Hand	Prize Amount
Ace - Ace (Any Suit)	\$20 - \$200

Eligibility

- There is a minimum of three players required to be playing in a designated game in order for the table to be eligible for the promotion.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a floor person will verify that both hands qualify. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the promotion.
- In order to qualify for the promotion, the player must complete play on all four rounds of the hand, which includes the pre-flop, the flop, the turn, and the river, and not fold their hand.
- In order to qualify for the promotion, the player must complete the applicable bets on each round. If the player goes all-in, this is considered to have completed all bets.
- In order to qualify for the promotion, the player must lose the hand on the showdown, after the final round of betting.
- In the event that during a round of play, two or more players have qualifying hands, the player closest to the left of the dealer button spins the wheel.
- In order to qualify for the promotion, the player dealt the qualifying hand must use both hole cards.
- The wheel must make four complete rotations for the spin to be valid.

- Once the wheel has been spun and is in motion, no one may interfere with the rotation of the wheel. Any interference with the rotation of the wheel shall invalidate the spin, and the wheel shall be re-spun.
- The wheel must come to a complete stop before a determination is made as to amount won. For a spin to be valid, the pointer must come to rest between two of the pegs. If the pointer gets stuck or rests upon one of the pegs, the spin shall be invalid and the wheel shall be re-spun. All spins that are declared invalid by the supervising floor-person shall be re-spun as per these rules.
- On duty employees shall not be eligible to participate in this promotion.
- All procedures, times, qualifying hands, and prize amounts must be displayed prominently at all time that the Aces Cracked Promotion is being offered for play via any form of advertising that the Rancho's Club Casino wishes to use, including but not limited to printed flyers, digital display, the Casino's website, etc.

The Rancho's Club Casino personnel will review the winning event to ensure all procedures were adhered to, as well as whether the play of all players was in accordance with industry standards. Discussion or collusion between players in an attempt to win the jackpot is prohibited. Such behavior disqualifies those players and may result in the players being barred. Any irregularity or discrepancy will void eligibility to win the jackpot as well. If a qualifying hand occurs, a floor person will verify the hands.

The jackpot prize pool is house funded by the Rancho's Club Casino. All table fees and limits are for the designated base game of Texas Hold'em and are Bureau approved, pre-determined and posted at each table.

The Aces Cracked Promotion will be offered for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with no restrictions, to patrons who wish to participate in a No Purchase Necessary game. The Rancho's Club Casino will provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the jackpot without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. The NPN player must adhere to all rules as the live player. All advertisements state "No Purchase Necessary" for the Aces Cracked Promotion.

Advertising

Rancho's Club Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001131) will be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, will be prominently displayed in Rancho's Club Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Bonus chip values
- Buy-in amount for Bonus Chips
- Procedures to redeem Bonus Chips
- Any other applicable restrictions and/or information.

Eligible Controlled Games

The Bonus Chip Promotion will be attached to all Bureau approved California games offered at Rancho's Club Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules will be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Bonus Chip Promotion will be open to all patrons who buy-in to a pre-determined game for a pre-determined amount ranging from \$10 to \$100,000. Participants will receive a specific amount of bonus chips in any controlled game listed above.

The prize will be awarded to the player when he/she redeems one of the aforementioned advertisements. The player will receive the advertised amount of bonus chips. The bonus chips are a different style and design from the standard casino chip. The bonus chips cannot be exchanged for cash and must be played on the gaming table. Once the bonus chip has been placed as a wager the following applies:

- If the wager wins, the player will receive live casino chips for his/her bet from the playerdealer. The player retains the bonus chips and can reuse the bonus chips on another wager.
- If the player pushes, the bonus chips will remain with the player until the hand loses.
- If the wager loses, the bonus chips are given to the player-dealer. The losing bonus chips are verified by a casino representative and redeemed at the cage by the casino cage staff members for the player-dealer. A casino representative will exchange the bonus chips with live casino chips for the player-dealer.
- Players may wager the bonus chips on bonus bets.
- Bonus chips will not be used to pay collections or jackpot fees.

Eligibility Requirements

- Players will not exchange bonus chips for live chips.
- The bonus chips are non-transferable between players.
- Players can take the bonus chips and use them at a later date.
- The bonus chips do not expire.
- The bonus chips have no cash value and cannot be redeemed for cash at anytime.
- There is minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, required in the controlled game for this promotion.
- The bonus chips will only be redeemed by the player-dealer after having been played and verified by a casino representative.
- Casino employees off duty and out of uniform are eligible for the promotion.
- The player-dealer position is not eligible to participate in the promotion.

<u>Prize</u>

The prize will be a fixed amount ranging from \$10 to \$10,000 in the form of bonus chips.

Funding

The Bonus Chip Promotion will be fully funded by Rancho's Club Casino. There will be no additional fees or collections taken for this gaming activity.

Administrative Fees

There will be no administrative fee(s) collected by Rancho's Club Casino for this promotion, as this promotion is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Bonus Chip Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Advertising

Rancho's Club Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001132) will be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, will be prominently displayed in Rancho's Club Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Required amount of time to be played and corresponding points earned
- The date(s) and time(s) the activity shall be offered
- All prizes offered and specific amount of points required for each prize
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Customer Incentive Program shall be attached to all Bureau approved games offered at Rancho's Club Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Customer Incentive Program is a house-funded promotion open to all Rancho's Club Casino patrons. The promotion will reward players with points based on time of play at designated tables during predetermined and posted time periods ranging from 10 minutes to 365 days. The range of points per hour played will range from 1 to 200,000. During predetermined and posted times, bonus rates may be offered by the Casino (for example, double points may offered during off-peak hours).

How Points are Earned Based on Time Played

Points shall be earned based on the amount of time played. Each player that plays at a predetermined and posted table and has their player's card scanned by a casino representative will earn points based on time played, which can be redeemed for prizes during or at the end of a predetermined and posted promotional period.

Example: A player signs up for the Customer Incentive Program at the cashier and receives a player's card. The player presents the card to a casino representative at the gaming table. The casino representative enters the player into the tracking software and will input the type of game and average wager per hand in 15-30 minute increments. At the end of the gaming session, the player will be logged out by the casino representative. The tracking software tabulates the amount of points the player earned based on time played and adds it to the player's account.

How Prizes are to be Redeemed

Players may redeem their points for prizes at any time during the promotion or at the end of the promotional period. All prizes shall have a predetermined and designated value. Prizes shall be earned by the amount of time played during the promotional period. After a player has accumulated a predetermined and specific amount of points, a player may redeem the accrued points for a predetermined and designated prize.

- After a player has been awarded a prize, they may also be eligible for multiple and subsequent prize(s) until the end of the promotion.

- The card shall be non-transferable and revocable at any time.
- If the Player's Card is lost or stolen, they can ask a casino representative for a replacement at no cost to the player.
- Player information shall be maintained in a secure database accessible only by casino management. Access to the database shall also be tracked by casino management.
- Player's time is tracked by having their card either scanned or manually entered into the tracking software.
- A printable record of the amount of time a player has accumulated during the promotional period shall be available at any time it is requested by the player.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity will be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- Players must be 21 or older and provide a valid ID to sign up for a player's card.
- In order for a poker game to qualify for this promotion, there must be a minimum of two players dealt in to the game.
- In order for a California game to qualify for this promotion, there must be a minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, dealt in to the game.
- Backline bettors are not eligible for this promotion.
- Players must play for a minimum of 10 minutes to qualify for this promotion.
- Casino employees are eligible for this promotion when off duty and out of uniform.
- Third Party Proposition Players are not eligible for this promotion at any time.
- A patron who assumes the player-dealer position will not be logged out of the system and shall continue to have their time tracked.
- Tournament games do not qualify for this promotion.

<u>Prize</u>

The prize shall be a fixed amount ranging from \$1 to \$100,000. Prizes include cash, live casino chips, Bonus Chips (GEGA-001131), Free Play Chips/Match Play Coupons (GEGA-002961), vehicles, promotional merchandise, food, entry into tournaments (GEGA-000499), or entry into other Bureau-approved gaming activities, which include the Prize Drawing (GEAR-001135) and Rewards Drawing (GEGA-002883) promotions. All prizes for this promotion will be predetermined and posted in advance throughout the gaming floor, and in all literature promoting such event.

Funding

The Customer Incentive Program shall be fully funded by Rancho's Club Casino. No additional fees of any kind shall be taken for this promotion.

Administrative Fees

Rancho's Club Casino shall not retain any administrative fee as this promotion is house-funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Customer Incentive Program does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary Table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Eligible Controlled Games

The Free Play Chips Promotion will be attached to all Bureau approved California games offered at Rancho's Club Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules will be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

Patrons are awarded Free Play Chips or Match Play Coupons via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, winning a Bureau approved promotion, winning or signing up for a Bureau approved tournament. Players who receive a Free Play Chip(s) or Match Play Coupon will be eligible to win the specific amount on the chip and/or coupon. Players will not exchange the Match Play Coupons or Free Play Chips for live casino chips. All applicable collection fees will be paid when using a Free Play Chip or Match Play Coupon. Free Play Chips and Match Play Coupons may not be used to pay collection fees or jackpot fees.

Free Play Chip

The Free Play Chips are used in live games exactly like regular casino chips, the difference being they cannot be exchanged for cash. Free Play Chips will initially be in the form of a coupon, which will be offered to all patrons that wish to come to the Casino and use them to play. When a patron receives a Free Play Coupon he or she will take the coupon to the cage for verification, logging, and redemption of the Free Play Chip(s) to be used in a live game. Free Play Chips will be used as the player's wager on the betting circle. Free Play Chips will not be taken into the house dealer's tray, nor will they be paid from the house dealer's tray.

- If a player uses a Free Play Chip and wins the hand, the player will receive the value of the Free Play Chip in live casino chips, paid by the player-dealer. The Free Play Chip is taken to the cage by the casino representative, logged and exchanged for the value listed on the chip. The live casino chips will be brought back to the player-dealer.
- If the player who played the Free Play Chip loses the hand, the Free Play Chip will be given to the player-dealer. A casino representative will verify the chip has been played. The Free Play Chip will then be collected by the house dealer and dropped into the drop box for accounting purposes.

• If the player pushes (receives no action) the hand, the Free Play Chips may be played again until the player wins or loses the hand.

Example: A player receives a \$5 Free Play Chip coupon/voucher to play on any California game. The player would take the coupon/voucher to the cage. Cage personnel would log the redemption code of the coupon/voucher and exchange the coupon/voucher for a promotional Free Play Chip. The player would then place the \$5 Free Play Chip on the gaming table, pay the posted collection fee (if applicable) and the game would play.

Match Play Coupon

A player will take a Match Play Coupon to an eligible game and place a wager that equals the amount on the coupon.

- If a player uses a Match Play Coupon and wins the hand, the player will receive the combined value of the Match Play Coupon and the equal wager placed by the player, paid by the player-dealer. The house dealer will have a casino representative sign the voucher verifying the coupon has been used. Winning Match Play Coupons will be taken to the cage to be logged and exchanged for the value listed on the coupons/vouchers. The live casino chips will be brought back to the player-dealer.
- If a player uses a Match Play Coupon and loses the hand, the player will lose the Match Play Coupon as well as their equal live casino chip portion. The player-dealer will be paid the live chip wager of the bet. The Match Play Coupon will be collected and voided.
- If a player uses a Match Play Coupon and the hand pushes, the player will retain both the Match Play Coupon as well as the equal live chip wager to be used again until he or she wins or loses.

Example: A player receives a Match Play Coupon with a value of \$5 for any California game. The player would take the coupon to the gaming table, place a bet that matches the amount on the coupon/voucher and pay the posted collection (if applicable) for a single hand of play.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity will be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- There are no minimum or maximum players needed for this promotion to be active.
- Backline bettors are eligible to participate and win in this promotion.
- There is no limit to the number of times Free Play Chips or Match Play Coupons that can be used.
- There is no limit to the number of Free Play Chips or Match Play Coupons that can be played at one time.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate and win in this promotion when off duty and out of uniform.
- The player-dealer position is eligible to win Free Play Chips or match play coupons, but cannot use them as a wager.
- Free Play Chips or Match Play Coupons cannot be used on bonus bets.
- Tournament games do not qualify for this promotion.
- Free Play Chips do not expire.
- Free Play Chips and Match Play Coupons are still subject to collection fees.
- Match Play Coupons expire and the expiration date will be clearly displayed.

<u>Prize</u>

Free Play Chip(s) and/or Match Play Coupons will have a value ranging from \$5 to \$500 for each Free Play Chip or Match Play Coupon. Players will not exchange Free Play Chip(s) or Match Play Coupon(s) for live casino chips.

Funding

The Free Play Chips promotion will be fully funded by Rancho's Club Casino. There will be no additional promotion fees or jackpot fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate.

Administrative Fees

There will be no administrative fee(s) collected for this promotion, as it is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Free Play Chips Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

 - a. Qualifying Hands:

A player must have a hand in which all 7 cards, 2 card top hand and 5 card bottom hand are 9 or lower, Aces being high, with no pair, straight, flush or joker.

b. Prize:

If another player at the table achieves a hand associated with an Envy pay, all other players who paid the optional \$1 jackpot fee will win the Envy pay. The player who achieves a qualifying hand is only eligible for the normal prize and will NOT receive the Envy pay.
- In the event that more than one player achieves a hand associated with an Envy pay, all other players will receive multiple Envy payouts. The players who achieved the qualifying hands are only eligible for the normal prize and will NOT receive the Envy pay.
- If a player's hand triggers an Envy payout, the house dealer will leave the hand face-up on the layout; otherwise, the house dealer will lock up the cards. The house dealer will then move on to the next player.
- All Envy Bonus payouts will be paid by a casino representative at the end of the round. Once the proper paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner(s) in live casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray. All Envy Bonus payouts will be deducted from the amount in the reserve fund.

Alternative Prize Option

When predetermined, posted, and offered, winners of the jackpot will have the option to claim a prize in the form of merchandise, vehicle, trips, gift certificates, clothing, jewelry, or tournament entries (GEGA-000499) in lieu of the entire posted jackpot prize. The merchandise will be assigned a monetary value that will be less than the actual retail value. The cost assigned will be reimbursed to Magnolia House Casino and any difference will be borne solely by the gambling establishment. Only one item will be offered and it will be up to the winners to decide who will get it. If the players cannot come to an agreement, the cash prize will be awarded as normal.

Example: A Vespa scooter that cost \$2,381 will be displayed in the gambling establishment with an assigned value of \$2,000. In this example, a player wins a jackpot with a posted prize of \$5,000. They will have the option of taking all of the posted prize or taking \$3,000 and the scooter which will total \$5,000. The Casino will be reimbursed (from the jackpot prize pool) only \$2,000 and they will expense the remainder (\$381) within their bookkeeping. The rest of the jackpot prize will be awarded as normal.

- Once a winner is determined, the chosen player must decide how they will claim their jackpot prize.
 - Either the original prize or a combination of the original prize and the posted alternative prize.
- One Alternative Prize Option (when offered) will be available per jackpot per winner.
- All eligibility and prizes will be predetermined and posted.

Funding

The Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot is a player funded progressive jackpot. The jackpot features both fixed and progressive prizes. There is an optional \$1 jackpot fee required to be eligible for the prize. The jackpot fee must be placed along with a base game wager in order to participate in the jackpot.

Each \$1 jackpot fee will be broken down as follows:

- \$0.20 will be immediately posted on the meter.
- \$0.80 will be tracked in a reserve fund.

The Casino will initially seed the jackpot at \$500 to \$1,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot reserve fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino. There is no cap to the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot.

After the progressive jackpot is hit, it will be re-seeded by the reserve fund in an amount ranging between a minimum of \$500 to a maximum of \$10,000. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall.

Once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund, the re-seed amount will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and shall be documented in the accounting records. All increases and decreases to the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot fund shall be documented in the accounting records.

The reserve fund will also be used to pay out all fixed prize and Envy payout amounts. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will not be reimbursed.

Administrative Fees

Magnolia House Casino shall retain an administrative fee of \$8-\$12 per table per hour and is taken from the jackpot reserve fund. The administrative fee shall be utilized to cover expenses incurred for administering the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Equipment

The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this jackpot, which is used on each table eligible for this jackpot, has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI).

- When a player has a progressive winner, the house dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- The house dealer shall then contact a Casino representative.
- Once the casino verifies the progressive win, the Casino representative shall insert the key and rotate it to "JPH" and then press "J-pot" button. This records the win onto the Game Manager. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- Returning the key to the "Run" position will restore normal operation of the table, and adjust the meter appropriately for the prize won.
- When the house dealer reconciles all action (on behalf of the player-dealer), the house dealer presses "Game Over." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
- Once the "J-pot" button is pressed, the prize is logged into Game Manager.

Advertising

Magnolia House Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the</u> <u>Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001238) shall be referenced on all</u> <u>advertisements relating to this gaming activity.</u>

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Qualifying hands and corresponding prize amounts
- Jackpot fee amount and breakdown
- Availability of Alternative Prize Option & corresponding value
- Administrative fees
- Prize Payout structure
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at Magnolia House Casino, as shown below, at all times that this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• Ultimate Texas Hold'em (GEGR-002110)

Object and Summary

Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot considers the best hand(s) possible among each individual player's cards.

- 1. To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. The players may optionally place any bonus bets along with the optional jackpot fee of \$1.
- "Hockey Puck" discs shall be attached to the table in front of each betting position. These discs have a sensor and shall detect when a casino chip is placed on them. Players who wish to participate in the jackpot must place the optional jackpot fee on the sensor. The sensor shall then light up.
- 3. Once all players place their bets and/or jackpot fee, the house dealer shall press "Game Start" on the keypad. The sensors shall then light up, indicating participation in the progressive jackpot. The house dealer shall then remove all jackpot fees from the table. The jackpot fees shall be dropped into a separate and locked jackpot collection box and accounted for separately.
- 4. The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the base game. A player can qualify for the jackpot element of the game regardless of the outcome of the base game.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make one of the advertised qualifying hands, as shown below, shall be eligible to win their share of the posted prize amount, according to the payout options listed below. All qualifying hands within a chart must be offered together at all times:

* A Community Royal is a hand consisting of an ace, king, queen, jack and 10 of the same suit, all in the community cards. The Community Royal prize is paid to all players who place the optional \$1 jackpot fee on that hand and did not use any hole cards to complete the hand.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, are required to play for this gaming activity
- Only seated players, who have paid the optional \$1 jackpot fee and dealt a designated hand, are eligible for payouts (including a Community Royal).
- Backline bettors are not eligible to place a jackpot collection fee or receive the prize amount for a qualifying hand.
- There is no limit to how many times a player may win a progressive or fixed prize within a promotional period.
- A patron may place a base game wager as well as the optional \$1 jackpot fee on any unoccupied seat, as well as their own, and become eligible for multiple payouts.
- Casino employees are eligible for the Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot when off-duty and out of uniform.
- Tournament games are not eligible with this gaming activity.

Fixed Prizes

Envy Bonus

If another player at the table hits a hand associated with an envy pay, all other players who paid the \$1 jackpot fee win the envy pay. The player hitting the hand receives the normal prize pay only, and does NOT receive the envy pay.
- If a player's hand triggers an envy payout, the house dealer shall leave the hand face-up on the layout; otherwise, the house dealer shall lock up the cards. The house dealer shall then move on to the next player.
- The house dealer pays any Envy Bonuses at the end of the round. The payouts will be paid from the cage, not from the house dealer's tray.

Alternative Prize Option

When predetermined, posted, and offered, winners of the jackpot will have the option to claim a prize in the form of merchandise, vehicle, trips, gift certificates, clothing, jewelry, or tournament entries (GEGA-000499) in lieu of the entire posted jackpot prize. The merchandise will be assigned a monetary value that will be less than the actual retail value. The cost assigned will be reimbursed to Magnolia House Casino and any difference will be borne solely by the gambling establishment. Only one item will be offered and it will be up to the winners to decide who will get it. If the players cannot come to an agreement, the cash prize will be awarded as normal.

Example: A Vespa scooter that cost \$2,381 will be displayed in the gambling establishment with an assigned value of \$2,000. In this example, a player wins a jackpot with a posted prize of \$5,000. Funding

The Casino shall initially seed the jackpot in an amount between \$1,000 and \$10,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot reserve fund, the initial seed shall be reimbursed to the Casino and shall be documented in the accounting records. After the progressive jackpot is hit, it shall be reseeded by the reserve fund in an amount between \$1,000 and \$50,000. If there are not sufficient monies in the reserve fund, the Casino will cover any shortfall and shall not be reimbursed. The progressive prize pool shall increase daily based solely on the number of jackpot collection fees placed and collected each day. Furthermore, there is no cap on this progressive prize pool.

Each \$1.00 jackpot fee paid by a player shall be broken down as follows:

- \$0.30 shall be immediately posted on the meter.
- \$0.70 shall be tracked in a reserve fund. The reserve fund shall be utilized to immediately reseed the metered progressive jackpot prize in an amount ranging from \$1,000 to \$50,000. In addition this reserve fund shall payout all fixed amounts and pay all administrative fees.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall take an administrative fee of \$8 - \$16 per table per hour. The administrative fee shall be taken from the reserve fund. The fee shall cover the costs associated with administering and accounting for the progressive jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot</u>. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Equipment

The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this jackpot, which is used on each table eligible for this jackpot, has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI).

- 1. When a player has a progressive winner, the dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- 2. The house dealer shall then contact a casino representative.
- 3. Once the casino verifies the progressive win, a casino representative will press "Confirm", then swipe the authorization card. This records the win onto the Game Manager. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- 4. When the house dealer reconciles all action (on behalf of the player/dealer), he/she presses "Game Over." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
- 5. Once the "Confirm" button is pressed, the prize is logged into Game Manager.
- 6. If the electronic software or digital reader malfunctions or breaks down, the jackpot will not be offered.
