

CHILD ABUSE CENTRAL INDEX (CACI) INQUIRY REQUEST FOR OUT-OF-STATE FOSTER CARE & ADOPTION AGENCIES

Pursuant to California Penal Code section 11170, subdivision (e)(1), the California Department of Justice (DOJ) shall make CACI information available to out-of-state foster and adoption agencies for purposes of approving a prospective foster or adoptive parent in compliance with the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006.
