


STOP DATA COLLECTION FORM


- The data collected on this form must be electronically submitted to the California Department of Justice (DOJ), Stop Data Collection System by entry into the Web Application or submission by Web Services or Secure File Transfer.

- If multiple persons are related to one stop, complete a separate form (sections III-IX) for each person and report as one incident.


RIPA Data Touching on Immigration Issues

- RIPA captures stops made in conjunction with a non-reporting agency (e.g., working with a joint task force with a federal agency, etc.)
- LEOs also record whether the stop resulted in the reporting officer contacting DHS
 - ~ 500 per year in 2022, 2023, and 2024
- Review of Narrative Fields
 - About Equally Common – CBP or TSA, about 2000
 - Involvement with ICE – Rare, less than 100
- Limited Data Directly from ICE Starting January 1, 2025



Possible Topics for Exploration in 2027 Report

- Expand on Immigration Analysis and include 2025 data
- Expand on Transportation Analysis
 - Differentiate Calls for Service from Officer-Initiated Stops
 - Differentiate by Number of Passengers
- Longitudinal Analysis
 - Consent Search Rates, Search/Discovery Rates,
 - Call for Service or Officer-Initiated, Loitering Stop Rates
 - Mental Health Related Stops and Outcomes
 - Use of Force
