Background

- Part of this Council's charge is to evaluate trainings.
- During the October 18, 2024, meeting, the Council authorized DOJ to develop an evaluation tool to assist the Council in these evaluations.
- DOJ is presenting this draft tool for your feedback, questions, and approval.



Timing Considerations

- The Council's two-year charge ends April 2026
- The Council is charged with evaluating trainings and drafting a report to the Legislature with DOJ's support.
- Evaluations should start as soon as possible to ensure that the Council has adequate time to evaluate trainings and make recommendations.

 - Evaluator Data
 - Instructor and Training Background
 - Substantive Overview of Training
 - Course Evaluation
