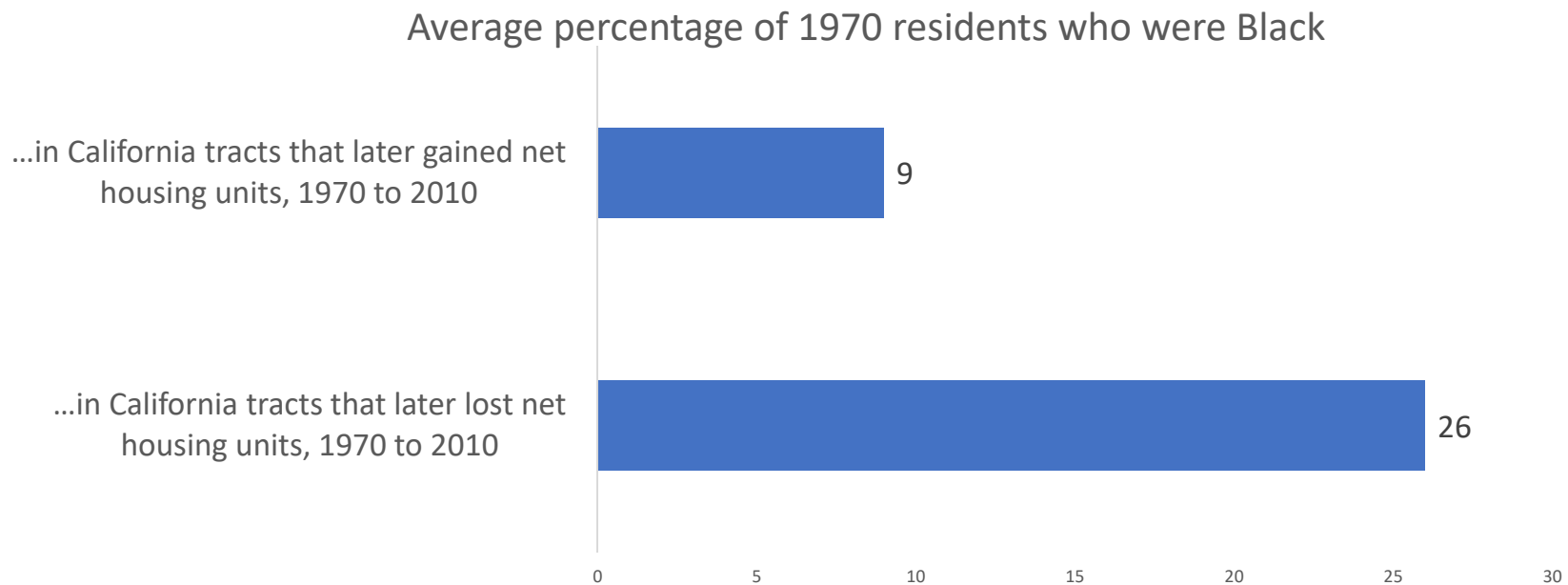

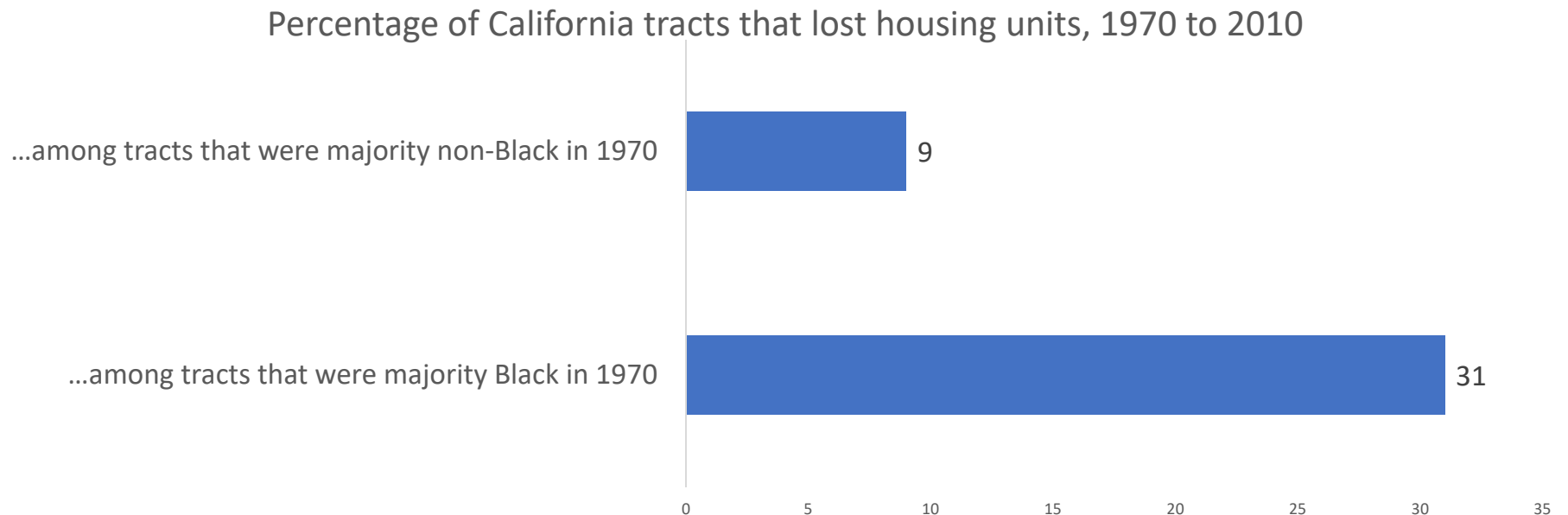

# California Census tracts that lost net housing units after 1970 were disproportionately Black



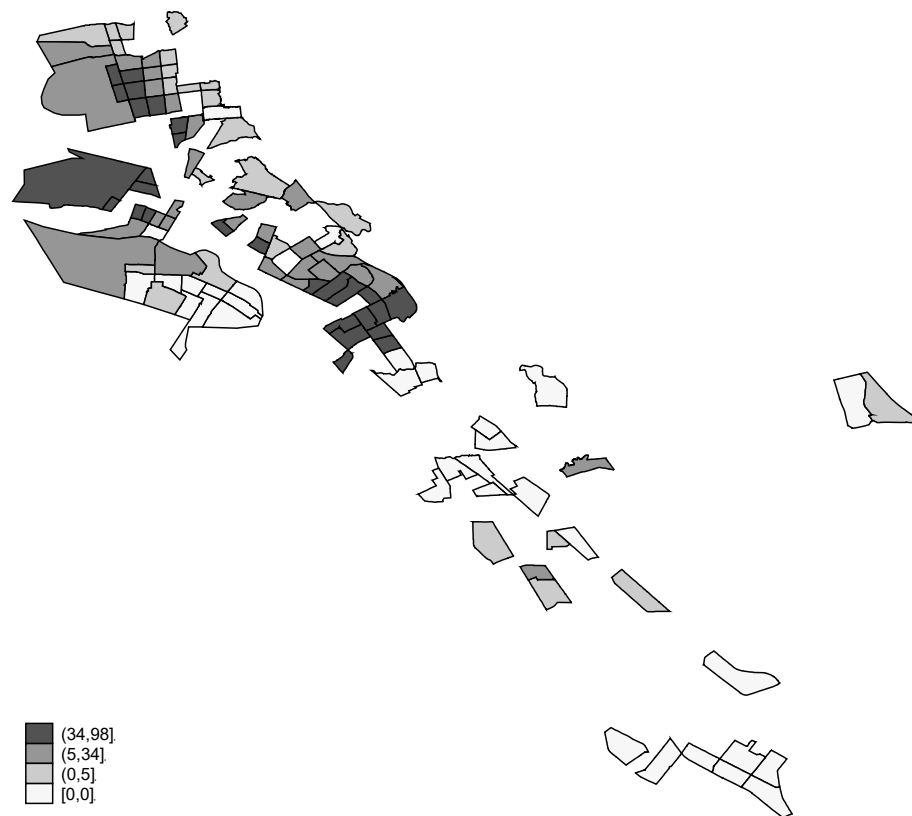

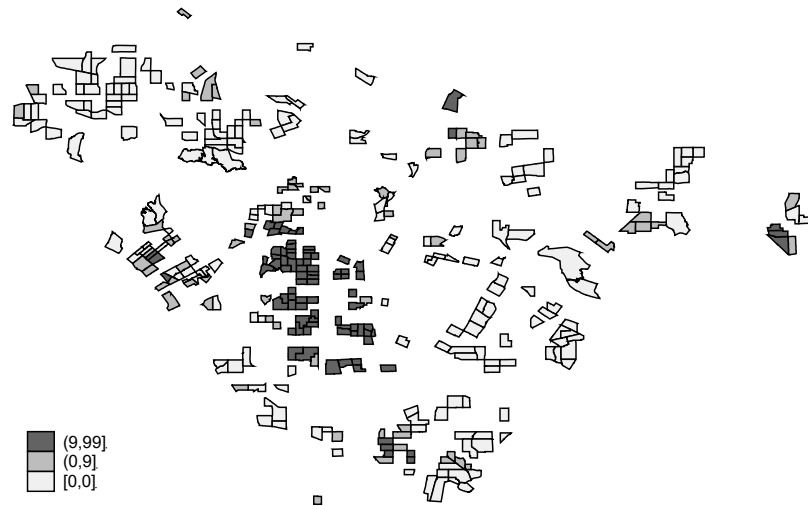
# Percentage of residents who were Black in selected Census tracts, Alameda County, 1970
