Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Westlane Card Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001201) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Westlane Card Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Qualifying hands
- Prize amount and prize description
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Aces Cracked gaming activity shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled game offered at Westlane Card Room, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

- Texas Hold'em (GEGA-002020)

Object and Summary

The Aces Cracked gaming activity features a fixed prize element attached to the eligible controlled game listed above. A prize is awarded to players participating in an eligible game when a hand containing a Pocket Pair of aces is beaten by a better hand at the showdown. In all instances, patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of the rules and restrictions in order to qualify for the Aces Cracked gaming activity.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make a hand that contains a Pocket Pair of aces and loses to a better hand will be eligible to win the Aces Cracked prize amount, as shown below. Only the following hands that have been Bureau approved, predetermined and designated by the Casino are eligible. All qualifying hands within each chart must be offered together at all times. Only one of the three qualifying hand charts shall be offered at a time.

Aces Cracked

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- There is a minimum of two players required to be dealt in during a qualifying game in order for players to be eligible and the table to qualify for the promotional prize
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a casino representative will verify that the hand qualifies. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the prize.
- In order to qualify for the promotion, the player dealt the qualifying losing hand must use both hole cards.
- In order to qualify for the promotion, both players must complete all applicable bets. If the player goes all-in, this is considered to have completed all bets.
- In order to qualify for the prize, the player must lose the hand at the showdown.
- In the event that more than one player has the same qualifying hand, the prize will be split equally between qualified players.

Prize

A player that receives the qualifying losing hand will receive a fixed amount ranging from \$25 - \$1,000 in the form of cash or live casino chips. All prizes for this gaming activity shall be pre-determined and posted in advance, throughout the gaming floor and in all literature promoting such an event.

A casino representative will pay all prizes. Once the proper paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner(s) in live casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray; the live casino chips will come from the cage.

Funding

The Aces Cracked gaming activity shall be fully funded by Westlane Card Room. At no time will any fees be collected from the players for the purpose of funding the promotion.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall not retain any administrative fee, as this promotion is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Aces Cracked promotion shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Aces Cracked promotion. *Both winning and losing hands must use at least two hole cards in order to qualify for the jackpot.

Object and Summary

The Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot utilizes two player-funded progressive prize pools, a Big Bad Beat Jackpot and a Small Bad Beat Jackpot, which will be funded by a mandatory \$1 collection fee that shall be taken from the pot, which is in addition to the house collection fee(s). A prize is awarded to players participating in a jackpot game when a designated second hand is beaten by a better qualifying hand at the showdown. When the winning and losing hands are confirmed, those players with the qualifying jackpot hands shall receive the posted percentage of the progressive jackpot prize. Additionally, a posted percentage of the jackpot prize, referred to as the Table Share, shall be evenly distributed among all other players at the qualifying table who have participated in the designated game, as shown below. A posted percentage of the jackpot prize, referred to as the Room Share, shall also be evenly distributed among all players in the Casino playing at an eligible table when the jackpot is awarded. In all instances, patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of the rules and restrictions in order to qualify for the Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot.

Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot

Qualifying Hands

Players that make the following advertised hands shall be eligible to win their share of each of the Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot prize amounts, as shown below. Only winning and losing hands that have been Bureau approved and predetermined and designated by the Westlane Card Room are eligible. Both qualifying hands listed below shall be offered together at all times. Furthermore, they shall be displayed prominently via printed flyers, digital display, or any other form of advertisements.

The designated qualifying losing hand for the Big Bad Beat Jackpot shall remain at Quad 8's until the jackpot reaches the cap of \$250,000. Once the cap has been reached, the qualifying losing hand will progressively lower at designated and posted times each day as shown below. The qualifying losing hand shall reset back to Quad 8's at 6:00 am each day.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of four active players are required to be dealt in during a qualifying game in order for the players and the table to qualify for the jackpot in No Limit/Pot Limit games.
- A minimum of five active players are required to be dealt in during a qualifying game in order for the players and the table to qualify for the jackpot in Limit games.
- Tournament games do not qualify for the jackpot.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate when off duty and out of uniform.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a casino representative will verify that both hands qualify. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- The players with the qualifying winning and losing hands must complete the applicable bets on each round and play through the final betting round (the showdown) in order to qualify for the jackpot.
- Only the highest ranked qualifying winning and losing hand shall be eligible for the posted prize payout. All other players shall receive their share of the Table Share payout.

Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot

- In the event that during a round of play, two or more players have the same qualifying losing or winning hands, all players with the same qualifying losing and winning hands shall split the posted percentage of the jackpot prize for the losing and/or winning hand equally.
 - The remaining players at the table, who do not include players that received a qualifying losing or winning hand, shall receive the posted prize percentage of the Table Share.
 - A posted percentage of the jackpot prize, referred to as the Room Share, shall also be evenly distributed among all players in the Casino playing at a table when the jackpot is awarded.
- Players are only eligible to receive one prize payout (i.e., a player who receives a Table Share payout is not also eligible for a Room Share payout).

Prize

- Prizes will be paid in the form of live casino chips or cash.
- In the event there are an odd number of chips to split between multiple players, the Casino will ensure each patron is paid the same amount and will cover any shortfall at their expense.
- All prizes will be paid immediately when possible. If any prize cannot be paid to the player(s) immediately, they will be paid within 72 hours.

Prize Payout Structure

Players that make the designated qualifying hands will be eligible to win their share of the Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot prize amount, based on the payout table being used, as shown below. Only one of these prize payout structure options shall be offered at any one time that the Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot is being offered for play. They shall not be offered together at any time nor may any combination of the prize payout structure options be offered together at any time that this gaming activity is being offered. Patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of which prize payout structure option is being offered for play. Once a prize payout structure option is designated by the Casino, the payout structure shall not be adjusted or changed until the jackpot has been hit and awarded. Furthermore, the prize payout structure will be displayed prominently via printed flyers, digital display, and any other forms of advertisements.

Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot

*The Table Share shall be evenly distributed among all other players at the table who are participating in a designated game that is eligible for the jackpot when the jackpot is awarded.

**The Room Share shall be evenly distributed among all the players in the Casino playing at a table when the jackpot is awarded, including all players at the eligible table where the jackpot was won.

Funding

The Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot utilizes two player-funded progressive prize pools, a Big Bad Beat Jackpot and a Small Bad Beat Jackpot, which will be funded by a mandatory \$1 collection fee that shall be taken from the pot at the same time as the house collection fee is taken. The jackpot fee will be placed in a separate collection box from the collection fees. The Big Bad Beat Jackpot shall be initially seeded by the Casino in an amount ranging between \$1,000 and \$100,000. The Small Bad Beat Jackpot shall be initially seeded by the Casino in an amount ranging between \$500 and \$50,000. The Casino shall be reimbursed the initial seed money from the reserve fund once sufficient funds have been collected. Neither jackpot shall increase past the initial seed amount until the Casino has been reimbursed from the reserve fund.

The Big Bad Beat Jackpot and Small Bad Beat Jackpot prize pools shall both increase daily in amounts ranging between \$5 and \$1,000. The amount each jackpot is separately increased by depends on the number of jackpot collection fees taken each day. Any monies not added to either jackpot shall be placed in the reserve fund. The Small Bad Beat Jackpot shall be capped at \$20,000. The Big Bad Beat Jackpot shall be capped at \$250,000. Once either jackpot is hit, it will be reseeded from the reserve fund. If there are not sufficient monies in the reserve fund, the Casino shall reseed the jackpot and shall be reimbursed from the reserve fund once sufficient monies are available. Neither jackpot shall increase beyond the reseed amount until the Casino has been fully reimbursed.

Administrative Fees

Westlane Card Room shall retain an administrative fee of \$8 per table per hour for the Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot. The administrative fee shall be taken from the reserve fund and will be used to cover the cost of marketing and operating the jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Poker Promotion

SUMMARY

Based on customer demand and industry trends, the Delta Casino(DC) proposes to add a gaming activity for all Texas Hold'em, Omaha, Seven Card Stud, Razz, and Lowball poker games. The promotion will award players who play the posted amount of time with instant cash in the form of casino chips.

PRIZE

The prize will be a fixed cash amount ranging from \$10.00 to \$100.00. The monies will be offered to players who buy in a predetermined and posted amount of money and play in a poker game for a predetermined and posted amount of time.

FUNDING

This promotion will be solely funded by DC. There will be no extra collection or fees of any kind assessed to the poker players.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY

Since there is not a “chance” element attached to this promotion there is not a requirement for the “no purchase necessary” procedure.

ELIGIBILITY

The promotion will be open to all players who buy in for the pre-determined and specified amount of chips in a poker game.

The time for a session of play by a participant will be verified by the poker floorperson. After the player has participated in a poker game for the specified amount of time, the player will receive the bonus cash in the form of DC chips.

The following details are offered:

- Eligible time periods will range from zero (0) to ten (10) hours
- At least four (4) players must be playing a poker game to qualify.
- Minimum buy-in will be \$10.00
- All procedures, times and cash amounts will be displayed prominently via printed flyers, digital display and any other forms of advertisements.

Cashpot Promotion

SUMMARY

Based on customer demand and industry trends, Delta Club Cardroom proposes to add a gaming activity to all currently approved controlled games offered at the gambling establishment. The promotion will reward players whose table is drawn, with an additional prize in the pot, or hand, during pre-determined and posted time periods.

RULES

The Cashpot Promotion will reward players at a table, when their table is drawn during the promotional period. A drawing bin will contain one separate, but equal sized envelope that will contain a card that depicts a table number that corresponds to each eligible table. At pre-determined times and intervals, a Cardroom employee will announce the commencement of the drawing promotion, and will rotate the drawing bin multiple times. Once the envelopes are thoroughly mixed, the Cardroom employee will randomly draw one concealed envelope and announce the table number to all players. The prize will then be distributed to the corresponding table in the following manner:

In all Poker style games:

When a Poker style game table number is drawn, a customer service representative will take the pre-determined and posted prize in the form of casino chips, or prize voucher to the corresponding table and will announce the the next pot is the 'Cashpot'. As soon as the next pot is formed, the customer service representative will place the chips or prize voucher into the pot and the round of play will continue as normal to its conclusion. The player who has the best hand wins the pot and the 'Cashpot' promotion prize.

In all CA/Asian style games:

When a CA/Asian style game table number is drawn, a customer service representative will take the pre-determined and posted prize in the form of casino chips, or prize voucher to the corresponding table and distribute the prize to all players. If a cash prize is awarded, each active player will split the 'Cashpot' prize amount, rounded up to the nearest dollar.

Example: If 6 players are playing at a Pai Gow Table, and the 'Cashpot' prize amount is \$1,000, then all 6 players receive an equal split of \$167.
(\$1,000 /6 = 166.66 rounded up to \$167).

If a non-cash prize is awarded, each active player will receive the posted promotional prize.

Example: If 6 players are playing at a Pai Gow table, and the 'Cashpot' prize is a 27" flat screen television, then all 6 players receive a prize voucher for a 27" flat screen television.

PRIZE

PRIZE

The prize will be a fixed cash amount ranging from \$50.00 to \$500.00 for player(s) when they have made and such has been recorded by DC personnel; the high poker hand for that specific time period. (See the Options section for details on the time period.)

OPTIONS

The high hand will be awarded from once a day to once per shift. The player with the high hand will be paid an instant cash prize ranging from \$50.00 to \$500.00 in casino chips.

FUNDING

This promotion will be solely funded by the DC. There will be no extra collection or fees of any kind assessed to the poker players.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY

A person who wishes to participate in this promotion for free, on a “no purchase necessary” (NPN) basis may do so by being at the NPN poker table at the specified time as in the live game. The NPN player must adhere to all rules as the live player.

EXAMPLE: A person receives a match play voucher with a value of \$5.00 that specifically states it may be used to place a wager on the Pai Gow Poker table. The person would place the voucher on the gaming table; place a bet that matches the amount on the voucher, and pay the posted collection (if applicable) for a single hand of play. If the player wins the hand, he/she will receive \$10.00 just as if they had placed a \$10.00 bet and the player-dealer will collect the voucher. The player/dealer will then have a key employee sign the voucher verifying that it has been won. All winning vouchers are verified and signed by a key employee. Winning vouchers are taken to the cage by the key employee, logged, and exchanged for the value listed on the coupon(s). If a player loses, the money part of the wager is collected by the player-dealer, and the voucher is voided and collected as well. If the player pushes (receives no action), the voucher may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

Free Play Chips

The free play chips are used in live games exactly like regular chips, the difference being that they cannot be exchanged for cash.

The free play chips shall initially be in the form of a coupon which shall be offered to all patrons that wish to come into the Casino and use them to play. Patrons may be awarded free play coupons via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, winning a Bureau approved promotion, winning or signing up for a Bureau approved tournament, etc. When a patron receives a free play coupon he/she shall take the coupon to the cage for verification, logging, and redemption of the free play chip(s) to be used in a live game. Each coupon shall state the specific qualifying game(s) that the free play chip(s) may be used on.

Promotional chips shall be used as the player's bet and placed on the betting circle.

Promotional chips shall not be taken into the dealer's tray, nor shall they be paid from the dealer's tray.

EXAMPLE: A person receives a free play chip coupon for \$10.00 that specifically states it can be used to place a wager on the No Bust Blackjack table. The player would take the coupon to the cage. Cage personnel would log the redemption code of the coupon and exchange the coupon

for a promotional free play chip. The player would then place the free play chip on the gaming table, pay the posted collection (if applicable), and the game would play. If the player wins the hand, he/she would be paid \$10.00 by the person in the player/dealer position just as if he/she had placed a \$10 bet. The free play chips are verified by a key employee. The free play chip is taken to the cage by a key employee, logged, and exchanged for the value listed on the chip. If the player loses the hand, the free play chip is forfeited and will be collected by the casino dealer and dropped in the drop box for accounting purposes. If the player pushes (receives no action), the chip may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

4. Prize is fixed based on the value of the math play coupon/free play chip.
5. The gaming activity is to be fully funded by Delta Casino. There shall be no additional promotion fees, jackpot fees, or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate.
6. There is no special fee collection involved in this promotion.
7. Prizes will be awarded in the manner listed above from the cage.
8. The prize will be awarded solely to the player that bets the match play coupon or free play chip.
9. N/A
10. There must be a minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer.

Delta Casino Non-negotiable Chip Program

Advertising Requirements

Delta Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-004091) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Delta Casino at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games.
- Eligible dates and time period(s).
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity.

Controlled Game

The Non-negotiable Chip Promotion will be attached to all limits and versions of the currently approved California games and Promotional activities (in form of a prize) offered at the Delta Casino. All base game rules will be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

Rules of Play

Patrons are awarded non-negotiable chips via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, winning a Bureau approved promotion, winning or signing up for a Bureau approved tournament. Players who receive a non-negotiable chip coupon shall be eligible to receive the specific amount printed on the coupon or individual chips. The player will go to the cage for verification, logging and redemption of the non-negotiable chips to be used in the specified live game. The non-negotiable chips shall be used as the player's wager and placed on the betting circle. The non-negotiable chips shall not be taken into the dealer's tray, nor shall they be paid from the dealer's tray.

Prize Amount

Each non-negotiable chip or coupon has a value ranging from \$5 to \$5,000. Players shall not exchange non-negotiable chips for live chips. Additionally, players shall not give non-negotiable chips to another player.

Non-negotiable Chips:

The prize shall be awarded to a player when he/she redeems one of the aforementioned advertisements. The player will receive the advertised amount of non-negotiable chips. The non-negotiable chips are of a different style and design from the standard casino chip. The non-negotiable chips can not be exchanged for cash and must be played on the gaming table. Once the non-negotiable chip has been placed as a wager the following applies:

Also, players may double down, split and buy insurance on Blackjack games or place Ante and Play bets on Three Card Poker. (If the player decides to play a "Player collection" game (I.E. Pai Gow Poker or Pai Gow Tiles), he/she must pay the collection fee in real casino chips.)
- Non-negotiable chips shall not be used to pay collections.

Purchasing Non-negotiable Chips:

The ticket shall be filled out with the player's name, table number, date, and a floor person's initials, then placed into a barrel or other non-electronic randomizer and the ticket(s) shall be drawn at posted times. The player whose ticket is drawn shall be awarded with the opportunity to spin the wheel in order to win a prize. The qualifying hand that meets all of the eligibility requirements shall be verified by Casino personnel. The wheel is separated into 64 separate sections with each section depicting a specific prize amount. The prize when a player who has a "Qualifying Hand" that is posted is up to the jackpot amount in casino chips, match-play coupons, free play chips, tournament entries, tickets, merchandise, gift cards, electronics, jewelry, trips, and vehicles. How Points are Redeemed

3. Once all players place their bets and/or jackpot fee, the house dealer will press "Coin In" on the keypad. The sensors will then light up, indicating participation in the progressive jackpot. The house dealer will then remove all jackpot fees from the table. The jackpot fees are dropped in a separate and locked jackpot collection box affixed to the left side of the gaming table.
4. The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the base game. The jackpot considers the best hand possible among the player's cards. A player can qualify for the jackpot element of the game regardless of the outcome of the base game.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- Only seated players who are dealt a designated hand and placed the optional jackpot fee are eligible for payouts.
- Backline bettors are not eligible to place a jackpot collection fee or receive the prize amount for a qualifying hand.
- A minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, are required to play in order to be eligible for the jackpot.
- There is no limit to the number of times a player can win a fixed or progressive prize during the promotional period.
- Players do not need to win the hand to qualify for a fixed or progressive prize.
- Casino employees are eligible for the Fortune Pai Gow Progressive only when off duty and out of uniform.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible to place a jackpot fee or become eligible for the Fortune Pai Gow Progressive.
- Tournament games are not eligible for this promotion.
- Players who are playing multiple hands are not eligible to place a jackpot fee on each hand. They are only eligible to place a jackpot fee on one hand and may only win one prize per round of play.
- The player-dealer position is not eligible to place a jackpot fee or qualify for this promotion.

Prize

The Fortune Pai Gow Progressive features both progressive and fixed prizes. All prizes will be paid by a casino representative. Once all proper paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner(s) in live casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray.

Progressive Prizes

- A 7 Card Straight Flush will pay 100% of the progressive jackpot amount shown on the progressive meter.
- Five Aces will pay 10% of the progressive jackpot amount shown on the progressive meter.

Fortune Pai Gow Progressive

- If more than one progressive prize hits on the same round of play all winning players will be paid the posted progressive prize.
 - One progressive prize will be paid from the progressive meter and the rest will be paid from the reserve fund.
 - In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will be reimbursed once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund.

Fixed Prize

- A Royal Flush will be paid a fixed amount of \$2,500 from the reserve fund.
- This prize will not get deducted from the amount shown on the meter.
- In the event more than one fixed qualifying hand hits during the same round, all winning players will be paid the posted fixed prize from the reserve fund.
- In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will be reimbursed once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund.

Funding

The Fortune Pai Gow Progressive is a player-funded jackpot with both fixed and progressive elements, which is funded by an optional \$1.00 jackpot fee. The Casino will initially seed the jackpot at \$1,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the Fortune Pai Gow Progressive reserve fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and will be documented in the accounting records. The Fortune Pai Gow Progressive does not have a prize cap.

After the progressive jackpot is hit, it will be re-seeded from the reserve fund at an amount between \$1,000 and \$10,000. In addition, this reserve fund will payout all fixed prize amounts. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will be reimbursed once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund.

The progressive prize meter shall increase daily based solely on the number of jackpot collection fees placed and collected each day. Each \$1.00 jackpot fee will be broken down as follows:

- a. \$0.20 will be immediately posted on the meter.
- b. \$0.80 will be tracked in a reserve fund.

All monies collected and paid out shall be tracked both electronically and on a hand written log that shall be maintained by the gambling enterprise, for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

Administrative Fees

The Casino will retain an administrative fee ranging in an amount between \$15 and \$20, taken per table per hour. The administrative fee will be taken from the reserve fund. The fee will cover the cost associated with the computer system and program in addition to technicians having to service the systems.

Fortune Pai Gow Progressive

No Purchase Necessary

The Fortune Pai Gow Progressive shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Fortune Pai Gow Progressive. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Equipment

The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this gaming activity has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International LLC (GLI). If there is a malfunction or the digital reader breaks a dice cup will be used.

- When a player has a progressive qualifying hand, the house dealer will press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- The house dealer will then contact a supervisor.
- Once a supervisor verifies the progressive win, the supervisor will insert the key and rotate it to "JPH" and then press "J-pot" button. This records the win onto the Game Manager computer. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- Returning the key to the "Run" position will restore normal operation of the table and adjust the meter appropriately for the prize won.
- When the house dealer reconciles all action, they press "END GAME." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
- Once the "J-pot" button is pressed, the prize is logged into the Game Manager.
 - If the progressive pay needs to be backed out (voided) at this point, the prize will need to be manually backed out using the Game Manager manual adjustment feature.
