21 MATEEL ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE FOUNDATION alleges as follows:

22 INTRODUCTION

23 1. This Complaint seeks civil penalties and an injunction to remedy the continuing  
24 failure of defendant MASTERCRAFT INTERNATIONAL USA, INC. (hereinafter  
25 "Defendant"), to give clear and reasonable warnings to those residents of California, who handle  
26 and use stained glass lamps that utilize lead solder, lead came and other leaded parts, (hereinafter  
27 referred to as "Leaded Stained Glass Lamps"), that handling and use of these products causes  
28 those residents to be exposed to lead and lead compounds, lead acetate, lead phosphate, and lead

1 subacetate (hereinafter, collectively, "lead"). The types of products to which this Complaint  
2 pertains are those types listed in the Product List appended to the Proposition 65 60-Day Notice  
3 Letter that is attached to and incorporated by reference into this Complaint. Lead is known to  
4 the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects and male and female reproductive toxicity.  
5 Defendant distributes, and/or markets Leaded Stained Glass Lamps. These products cause  
6 exposures to lead and lead compounds, which are chemicals known to the State of California to  
7 cause cancer, birth defects and other reproductive harm.

8 2. Defendant markets, and/or distributes Leaded Stained Glass Lamps. Defendant  
9 intends that residents of California handle and use Leaded Stained Glass Lamps that Defendant  
10 markets, and/or distributes. When these products are handled and used in their normally  
11 intended manner, they expose people to lead. In spite of knowing that residents of California  
12 were and are being exposed to these chemicals when they handle and use Leaded Stained Glass  
13 Lamps, Defendant did not and does not provide clear and reasonable warnings that these  
14 products cause exposure to chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects and other  
15 reproductive harm.

16 3. Plaintiff seeks injunctive relief pursuant to Health & Safety Code Section 25249.7  
17 to compel Defendant to bring its business practices into compliance with section 25249.5 *et seq.*  
18 by providing a clear and reasonable warning to each individual who has been and who in the  
19 future may be exposed to the above mentioned toxic chemicals from the use of Defendant's  
20 products. Plaintiff seeks an order that defendant identify and locate each individual person who  
21 in the past has purchased Leaded Stained Glass Lamps and to provide to each such purchaser a  
22 clear and reasonable warning that the Leaded Stained Glass Lamps will cause exposures to  
23 chemicals known to cause birth defects.

24 4. In addition to injunctive relief, plaintiff seeks civil penalties to remedy the failure  
25 of Defendants to provide clear and reasonable warnings regarding exposure to chemicals known  
26 to cause cancer, birth defects and other reproductive harm.

27 PARTIES

28 5. Plaintiff MATEEL ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE FOUNDATION ("Mateel")

1 is a non-profit organization dedicated to, among other causes, the protection of the environment,  
2 promotion of human health, environmental education, and consumer rights. Mateel is based in  
3 Eureka, California, and is incorporated under the laws of the State of California. Mateel is a  
4 "person" pursuant to Health & Safety Code Section 25118. Mateel brings this enforcement  
5 action in the public interest pursuant to Health & Safety Code §25249.7(d). Residents of  
6 California are regularly exposed to lead and lead compounds from Leaded Stained Glass Lamps  
7 manufactured, distributed or marketed by Defendants and are so exposed without a clear and  
8 reasonable Proposition 65 warning.

9         6. Defendant is a person doing business within the meaning of Health & Safety Code  
10 Section 25249.11. Defendant is a businesses that distributes, and/or markets Leaded Stained  
11 Glass Lamps in California, including the City and County of San Francisco. Distribution and/or  
12 marketing of these products in the City and County of San Francisco and/or to people who live in  
13 San Francisco, causes people to be exposed to lead and lead compounds while they are physically  
14 present in the City and County of San Francisco.

15         7. Plaintiff brings this enforcement action against Defendant pursuant to Health &  
16 Safety Code Section 25249.7(d). Attached hereto and incorporated by reference is a copy of a  
17 60-day Notice letter, dated July 24, 2007, which Mateel sent to California's Attorney General.  
18 Substantively identical letters were sent to every District Attorney in the state, and to the City  
19 Attorneys of every California city with a population greater than 750,000, and to defendant.  
20 Attached to the 60-Day Notice Letter sent to defendant was a summary of Proposition 65 that  
21 was prepared by California's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment. In addition,  
22 each 60-Day Notice Letter plaintiff sent was accompanied by a Certificate of Service attesting to  
23 the service of the 60-Day Notice Letter on each entity which received it. Pursuant to California  
24 Health & Safety Code Section 25249.7(d), a Certificate of Merit attesting to the reasonable and  
25 meritorious basis for the action was also sent with each 60-Day Notice Letter. Factual  
26 information sufficient to establish the basis of the Certificate of Merit was enclosed with the 60-  
27 Day Notice letter Mateel sent to the Attorney General.

28         8. Defendant employs more than ten people.



1 Health and Safety Code Section 25249.6 et seq. This conduct includes knowingly and  
2 intentionally exposing to the above mentioned toxic chemicals, those California residents who  
3 handle and use Leaded Stained Glass Lamps. The normally intended use of Leaded Stained  
4 Glass Lamps causes exposure to lead and lead compounds, which are chemicals known to the  
5 State of California to cause cancer, birth defects and other reproductive harm. Defendant has not  
6 provided clear and reasonable warnings, within the meaning of Health & Safety Code Sections  
7 25249.6 and 25249.11.

8 16. At all times relevant to this action, Defendant knew that the Leaded Stained Glass  
9 Lamps it, distributed or marketed were causing exposures to lead and lead compounds.  
10 Defendant intended that residents of California handle and use Leaded Stained Glass Lamps in  
11 such ways as would lead to significant exposures to these chemicals.

12 17. By the above described acts, Defendant has violated Cal. Health & Safety Code  
13 § 25249.6 and is therefore subject to an injunction ordering it to stop violating Proposition 65, to  
14 provide warnings to all present and future customers and to provide warnings to its past  
15 customers who purchased defendant's products without receiving a clear and reasonable warning.

16 SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION  
17 (Claim for Civil Penalties)

18 18. Plaintiff realleges and incorporates by reference into this Second Cause of Action,  
19 as if specifically set forth herein, paragraphs 1 through 17, inclusive.

20 19. By the above described acts, Defendant is liable and should be liable pursuant to  
21 Health & Safety Code § 25249.7(b), for a civil penalty of \$2,500.00 per day for each individual  
22 exposed without proper warning to lead and lead compounds from the handling or use of  
23 Defendant's Leaded Stained Glass Lamps.

24 PRAYER FOR RELIEF

25 Wherefore, plaintiff prays for judgment against DEFENDANT, as follows:

26 1. Pursuant to the First Cause of Action, that Defendant be enjoined, restrained, and  
27 ordered to comply with the provisions of Section 25249.6 of the California Health & Safety  
28 Code;

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2. Pursuant to the Second Cause of Action, that Defendant be assessed a civil penalty in an amount equal to \$2,500.00 per day per individual exposed, in violation of Section 25249.6 of the California Health & Safety Code, to lead and lead compounds as the result of Defendant's distributing or marketing of Leaded Stained Glass Lamps;


3. That Defendant be ordered to identify and locate each individual who purchased Leaded Stained Glass Lamps and provide a warning to each such person that the Leaded Stained Glass Lamps the person purchased will expose that person to chemicals known to cause birth defects.

4. That, pursuant to Civil Procedure Code § 1021.5, Defendant be ordered to pay to Plaintiff the attorneys fees and costs it incurred in bringing this enforcement action.

5. For such other relief as this court deems just and proper.



Greetings:

This office and the Mateel Environmental Justice Foundation ("Mateel") give you notice that private businesses listed on the attached service list have been, are, will be and threaten to be in violation of Cal. Health & Safety Code § 25249.6. Both this office and Mateel are private enforcers of Proposition 65, both may be contacted at the below listed address and telephone number, and I am a responsible individual at both Mateel and this office. The above referenced violations occur when California residents come into contact with leaded stained glass lamps. A list of specific examples of the specific types of products at issue is attached. The solder, came, and other parts used to manufacture these leaded stained glass lamps contains lead and lead compounds ("lead"), which are chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects and other reproductive harm. California residents are exposed to lead when they assemble, handle, clean, or otherwise use these products. Lead is transferred from the products to their hands and to other parts of their skin. This lead is then absorbed through the skin, taken into cuts and abrasions, absorbed through mucous membranes, and transferred from the skin to the mouth via oral contact either directly with the product, from oral contact with the lead-contaminated skin, and when lead is transferred from contaminated skin to cigarettes and food and the contaminated cigarettes and food are smoked and/or eaten. These lead exposures thus occur via the dermal absorption, subcutaneous, mucous membrane, ingestion and inhalation routes. The listed businesses did not and do not provide people with clear and reasonable warnings before these businesses expose them to lead. These violations have occurred every day since at least July 24, 2004, and will continue every day until the lead is removed from the lamps, or until clear and reasonable warnings are given. The above-referenced violations are alleged for occupational exposures as well as for consumer and environmental exposures. We do not, however, allege occupational exposure violations as to any leaded stained glass lamps made outside of California, except as to workplaces the companies themselves maintain in California. Exposures constituting Proposition 65 environmental exposure violations occur both on and off the private businesses' property and in each of California's 58 counties.

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This notice alleges the violation of Proposition 65 with respect to occupational exposures governed by the California State Plan for Occupational Safety and Health. The State Plan incorporates the provisions of Proposition 65, as approved by Federal OSHA on June 6, 1997. This approval specifically placed certain conditions on Proposition 65, including that it does not apply to the conduct of manufacturers occurring outside the State of California. The approval also provides that an employer may use the means of compliances in the general hazard communication requirements to comply with Proposition 65. It also requires that supplemental enforcement is subject to the supervision of the California Occupational Safety and Health Administration. Accordingly, any settlement, civil complaint, or substantive court orders in this matter must be submitted to the Attorney General.
