KINGPUN CHENG (hereinafter, "Plaintiff") brings this representative 23 action, in the public interest of the citizens of the State of California (hereinafter, "citizens"), to 24 enforce the citizen's right to be informed of the presence of Diisononyl Phthalate (hereinafter, 25 "DINP") and Butyl Benzyl Phthalate (hercinafter "BBP") found in Defendants ZOOM BAIT 26 COMPANY, INC., BIG BITE BAITS, INC., CRÈME LURE COMPANY, STRIKE KING 27 LURE COMPANY, PURE FISHING, INC., JARDEN CORPORATION, BASS ASSASSIN

- 3. Defendants manufacture, distribute or offer for sale Fishing Lures containing detectable levels of DINP or BBP to consumers throughout the State of California.
- 4. California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, California Health & Safety Code § 25249.5 et seq. ("Proposition 65") states, "No person in the course of doing business shall knowingly and intentionally expose any individual to a chemical known to the state to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity without first giving clear and reasonable warning to such individual..." (Cal. Health & Safety Code § 25249.6.)
- California identified and listed DINP as a chemical known to cause cancer under Proposition 65.
- 6. California identified and listed BBP as a chemical known to cause developmental toxicity under Proposition 65.
- 7. Defendants manufacture, distribute or offer for sale Fishing Lures containing DINP or BBP without providing a health hazard warning in California.
- 8. Defendants failure to warn consumers and/or other individuals in the State of California about their exposure to DINP or BBP in conjunction with Defendant's sale of Fishing Lures is a violation of Proposition 65 which subjects Defendant to enjoinment of such conduct as well as civil penalties for each such violation.
- 9. For Defendant's violations of Proposition 65, plaintiff seeks preliminary injunctive and permanent injunctive relief to compel Defendant to provide purchasers or users of Fishing Lures with the required warning regarding the health hazards of DINP and BBP. (Cal. Health & Safety Code § 25249.7(a).)
- 10. Plaintiff also seeks civil penalties against Defendant for its violations of Proposition 65, as provided for by *California Health & Safety Code § 25249.7(b)*.

### **PARTIES**

11. Plaintiff resides in the City of Carlsbad, County of San Diego, in the State of California and as such, as citizen of the state of California. Plaintiff is dedicated to protecting the health of California citizens through the elimination or reduction of toxic exposures from consumer products, represented by and through its counsel of record, Parker A. Smith. Plaintiff brings this action in the public interest pursuant to *California Health & Safety Code § 25249.7*.

- 12. ZOOM BAIT COMPANY, INC. is a person doing business within the meaning of California Health & Safety Code § 25249.11.
- 13. BIG BITE BAITS, INC. is a person doing business within the meaning of California Health & Safety Code § 25249.11.
- 14. CRÈME LURE COMPANY is a person doing business within the meaning of California Health & Safety Code § 25249.11.
- 15. STRIKE KING LURE COMPANY is a person doing business within the meaning of California Health & Safety Code § 25249.11.
- 16. PURE FISHING, INC. is a person doing business within the meaning of *California Health & Safety Code § 25249.11*.
- 17. JARDEN CORPORATION is a person doing business within the meaning of California Health & Safety Code § 25249.11.
- 18. BASS ASSASSIN LURES, INC. is a person doing business within the meaning of California Health & Safety Code § 25249.11.

### **VENUE AND JURISDICTION**

- 19. Venue is proper in the Alameda County Superior Court, pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure § § 394, 495, 395.5, because this Court is a court of competent jurisdiction, because one or more instances of wrongful conduct occurred, and continues to occur, in the County of Alameda and/or because Defendants conducted, and continue to conduct, business in this County with respect to Fishing Lures.
- 20. The California Superior Court has jurisdiction over this action pursuant to California Constitution Article VI, § 10, which grants the Superior Court "original jurisdiction in all causes except those given by statute to other trial courts." The statute under which this action is brought does not specify any other basis of subject matter jurisdiction.
- 21. The California Superior Court has jurisdiction over Defendants based on Plaintiff's information and good faith belief that each Defendant is a person, firm, corporation or association that is either a citizen of the State of California, has sufficient minimum contacts in the State of California, or otherwise purposefully avail itself of the California market. Defendants' purposeful

availment renders the exercise of personal jurisdiction by California courts consistent with traditional notions of fair play and substantial justice.

#### FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION

### (Violation of Proposition 65 - Against Defendant)

- 22. Plaintiff alleges and incorporates by reference, as if full reference, as if full set forth herein, Paragraphs 1 through 19, inclusive.
- 23. The citizens of the State of California have expressly stated in the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, California Health & Safety Code § 25249.5, et seq. (Proposition 65) that they must be informed "about exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects and order reproductive harm." (Cal. Health & Safety Code § 25249.6.)
- 24. Proposition 65 states, "No person in the course of doing business shall knowingly and intentionally expose any individual to a chemical known to the state to cause cancer or productive toxicity without first giving clear and reasonable warning to such individual (Id.)."
- 25. A sixty-day notice of violation, together with the requisite certificates of merit, was provided to Defendants, other potential violators and various public enforcement agencies, including the California Attorney General's Office, stating that as a result of the Defendants' sale of Fishing Lures, purchasers and users in the State of California were being exposed to DINP and BBP resulting from the reasonably foreseeable users of Fishing Lures, without the individual purchasers and users first having been provided with a "clear and reasonable warning" regarding such toxic exposures. The Defendants were provided with the requisite notice and supporting documents on the following dates:

A. ZOOM BAIT COMPANY, INC.	August 13, 2015
B. BIG BITE BAITS, INC.	July 17, 2017
C. CRÈME LURE COMPANY	June 16, 2017
D. STRIKE KING LURE COMPANY	August 13, 2015
E. PURE FISHING, INC.	August 13, 2015
F. JARDEN CORPORATION	August 13, 2015
G. BASS ASSASSIN LURES, INC.	July 15, 2016

26. A Supplemental sixty-day notice of violation, together with the requisite certificates

of merit, was provided to Defendants, other potential violators and various public enforcement agencies, including the California Attorney General's Office, stating that as a result of the Defendant's sale of Fishing Lures, purchasers and users in the State of California were being exposed to DINP and BBP resulting from the reasonably foreseeable users of Fishing Lures, without the individual purchasers and users first having been provided with a "clear and reasonable warning" regarding such toxic exposures. The Defendants were provided with the requisite notice and supporting documents on the following dates:

A. ZOOM BAIT COMPANY, INC.	July 10, 2017
B. STRIKE KING LURE COMPANY	July 10, 2017
C. PURE FISHING, INC.	July 10, 2017
D. JARDEN CORPORATION	July 10, 2017

27. Defendants manufacture, distribute and/or offer Fishing Lures for sale or use in violation of *California Health & Safety Code § 25249.6* and Defendants' manufacture, distribution and/or offering of Fishing Lures for sale or use in violation of *California Health & Safety Code § 25249.6* has continued to occur beyond Defendants' receipt of Plaintiff's sixty-day Notice of Violation and Supplemental Notice of Violation. Plaintiff further alleges and believes that such violations will continue to occur into the future.

- 28. After receipt of the claims asserted in the sixty-day notices of violation, the appropriate public enforcement agencies have failed to commence and diligently prosecute a cause of action against Defendant under Proposition 65.
- 29. The Fishing Lures manufactured, distributed, and/or offered for sale or use in California by Defendant contained DINP and BBP above the allowable state limits.
- 30. Defendants knew or should have known that the Fishing Lures manufactured, distributed, and/or for sale or use by Defendants in California contained DINP and BBP.
- 31. DINP and/or BBP was present in or on the Fishing Lures in such a way as to expose individuals to DINP and/or BBP through dermal contact and/or ingestion during the reasonably foreseeable use of the Fishing Lures.
  - 32. The normal and reasonably foreseeable use of the Fishing Lures have caused and

continue to cause consumer exposure to DINP and/or BBP as such exposure is defined by 27 CCR§ 25602(b).

- 33. Defendants had knowledge that the normal and reasonably foreseeable use of the Fishing Lures would expose individuals to DINP and/or BBP through dermal contact and/or ingestion.
- 34. Defendants intended that such exposures to DINP and/or BBP from the reasonably foreseeable use of the Fishing Lures would occur by its deliberate, non-accidental participation in the manufacture, distribution and/or offer for sale or use of the Fishing Lures to purchasers, consumers, or users in the State of California.
- 35. Defendants failed to provide a "clear and reasonable warning" to those consumers and/or other individuals in the State of California who were or who could become exposed to DINP and/or BBP through dermal contact and/or ingestion during the reasonably foreseeable use of the Fishing Lures.
- 36. Contrary to the express policy and statutory prohibition of Proposition 65, enacted directly by California voters, individuals exposed to DINP and/or BBP through dermal contact and/or ingestion resulting from the reasonably foreseeable use of the Fishing Lures, sold by Defendants without a "clear and reasonable warning," have suffered, and continue to suffer, irreparable harm, for which harm they have no plain, speedy or adequate remedy at law.
- 37. As a consequence of the above-described acts, each Defendants is liable for a maximum civil penal of \$2,500.00 per day for each violation pursuant to *California Health& Safety Code § 25249.7(b)*.
- 38. As a consequence of the above-described acts, *California Health & Safety Code §* 25249.7(a) also specifically authorizes the Court to grant injunctive relief against Defendants.
  - 39. Wherefore, Plaintiff prays for judgment against Defendants as set forth hereinafter.

## PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Wherefore, Plaintiff prays for judgment against Defendants as follows:

40. That the Court, pursuant to California Health & Safety Code § 25249.7(b), assess civil penalties against Defendants, in the amount of \$2,500.00 per day for each violation alleged herein;

41. That the Court, pursuant to *California Health & Safety Code § 25249.7(a)*, preliminarily and permanently enjoin Defendants from manufacturing, distributing or offering Fishing Lures for sale or use in California, without providing "clear and reasonable warnings" as detailed by 27 CCR § 25601, as to the harms associated with exposures to DINP and/or BBP;

42. That the Court grant Plaintiff reasonable attorneys' fees and cost of suit; and the Court grant such other and further relief as may be just and proper.
