COMPLAINT FOR CIVIL PENALTIES AND INJUCTIVE RELIEF

INTRODUCTION

- 1. California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act ("Toxic Enforcement Act" or "the Act"), Health & Safety Code § 25249.5 et seq., prohibits any person in the course of doing business from knowingly and intentionally exposing any individual to a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity, without first giving clear and reasonable warning of such exposure. Health & Safety Code § 25249.6. This prohibition applies with equal force against business entities that produce, distribute, or sell consumer products, where the reasonable intended use of such products would result in an exposure to a known carcinogen or reproductive toxin.
- 2. On February 27, 1987, the State of California officially listed lead as a chemical known to the State to cause reproductive toxicity.
- 3. On May 1, 1997, the State of California officially listed cadmium as a chemical known to the State to cause reproductive toxicity.
- 4. On information and belief, Defendants Huel Inc. and Huel Limited (collectively "Huel" or "Defendants") produce, distribute, and/or sell Huel Vanilla-Flavored Protein Meal Replacement Powder, and Huel Unflavored Protein Meal Replacement Powder (collectively "Covered Products") to California residents through Defendants' own website, https://huel.com/, and the retail seller Amazon.com, http://www.amazon.com.
- 5. Lead and cadmium are present in the Covered Products. Consumers are exposed to lead and cadmium when they ingest the Covered Products.
- 6. Defendants have failed to provide a clear and reasonable warning that ingestion of the Covered Products will result in exposure to lead and cadmium, chemicals known to the State of California to cause reproductive toxicity. Accordingly, Plaintiff As You Sow seeks an order requiring that Defendants take measures to ensure that California consumers ingesting the Covered Products are not exposed to harmful levels of lead and cadmium, or provide a clear and reasonable warning that ingestion of the Covered Products will result in exposure to chemicals, namely lead and cadmium, known to the State of California to cause reproductive toxicity.

PARTIES

- 7. Plaintiff AS YOU SOW ("Plaintiff") is an Oakland-based non-profit corporation dedicated to, among other causes, the protection of the environment, toxics reduction, the promotion of and improvement of human health, the improvement of worker and consumer rights, environmental education, and corporate accountability. As You Sow brings this action on its own behalf and in the public interest pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 25249.7(d).
- 8. Defendant HUEL LIMITED is, on information and belief, a business entity with ten or more employees that has produced, distributed, and/or sold in California the following products: Huel Vanilla-Flavored Protein Meal Replacement Powder, and Huel Unflavored Protein Meal Replacement Powder. On information and belief, Defendant Huel Limited is incorporated in the United Kingdom.
- 9. Defendant HUEL INC. is, on information and belief, the legal business entity and authorized agent for Defendant Huel Limited in the United States. On information and belief, Huel Inc. is a business entity with ten or more employees that has produced, distributed, and/or sold in California the following products: Huel Vanilla-Flavored Protein Meal Replacement Powder, and Huel Unflavored Protein Meal Replacement Powder.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 10. This Court has jurisdiction over this action pursuant to Article VI, § 10 of the California Constitution because this case is not a cause given by statute to other courts.
- 11. This Court has jurisdiction over Defendants because they are business entities that conduct sufficient business, have sufficient minimum contacts in, or otherwise intentionally avail themselves of the market in California through the manufacture, sale, distribution, and/or use of products in California.
- 12. Venue is proper in this Court because the obligation or liability arises, at least in part, in the County of Alameda.

LEGAL BACKGROUND

- 13. In 1986, the voters of California overwhelmingly enacted the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act. The Act is also commonly referred to as "Proposition 65."
- 14. The Preamble to the Toxic Enforcement Act ballot measure provides a clear statement of the purpose of the Act:

The people of California find that hazardous chemicals pose a serious potential threat to their health and well-being, that state government agencies have failed to provide them with adequate protection, and that these failures have been serious enough to lead to investigations by federal agencies of the administration of California's toxic protection programs. The people therefore declare their rights:

- (a) To protect themselves and the water they drink against-chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm.
- (b) To be informed about exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm.
- (c) To secure strict enforcement of the laws controlling hazardous chemicals and deter actions that threaten public health and safety
- 15. Among other requirements, the Toxic Enforcement Act provides that "[n]o person in the course of doing business shall knowingly and intentionally expose any individual to a chemical known to the State to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity without first giving clear and reasonable warning to such individual, except as provided in Section 25249.10." Health & Safety Code § 25249.6.
- 16. The Toxic Enforcement Act establishes a procedure by which the State is to develop a list of chemicals "known to the State to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity." Health & Safety Code § 25249.8. No warning is required for a chemical until one year after the State lists the chemical. Health & Safety Code § 25249.10(b).
- 17. The Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA), which is part of the California Environmental Protection Agency (CalEPA), is the lead agency charged with implementing Proposition 65. Health & Safety Code § 25249.12. OEHHA has promulgated regulations implementing Proposition 65. See 27 CCR § 25102 et seq.

- 18. On February 27, 1987, lead was placed on OEHHA's list of chemicals known to the State to cause reproductive toxicity. 27 CCR § 27001(b).
- 19. On May 1, 1997, cadmium was placed on OEHHA's list of chemicals known to the State to cause reproductive toxicity. 27 CCR § 27001(b).
- 20. According to applicable regulations, a warning for consumer product exposure is "clear and reasonable" if it is "prominently displayed on a label, labeling, or sign, ... with such conspicuousness as compared with other words, statements, designs or devices on the label, labeling, or sign, as to render the warning likely to be read and understood by an ordinary individual under customary conditions of purchase or use." 27 CCR § 2560 I(c); see also Dowhal v. SmithKline Beecham Consumer Healthcare (2004) 32 Cal.4th 910, 918 ("The warning may be communicated through product labeling, point-of-sale signs, or public advertising.").
- 21. According to applicable regulations, for internet purchases, a warning "must be provided by including either the warning or a clearly marked hyperlink using the word 'WARNING' on the product display page, or by otherwise prominently displaying the warning to the purchaser *prior to completing the purchase*." 27 CCR § 25602(b) (bold in original) (emphasis in italics added).
- 22. According to applicable regulations, a warning for consumer product exposure must include the following elements:
 - (1) A symbol consisting of a black exclamation point in a yellow equilateral triangle with a bold black outline. Where the sign, label or labeling for the product is not printed using the color yellow, the symbol may be printed in black and white. The symbol shall be placed to the left of the text of the warning, in a size no smaller than the height of the word "WARNING".
 - (2) The word "WARNING" in all capital letters and bold print, and:
 - ... (B) For exposures to listed reproductive toxicants, the words, "This product can expose you to [name of one or more chemicals], a chemical [or chemicals]

known to the State of California to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm. For more information go to www.P65Warnings.ca.gov/product."

- 23. A consumer product exposure is "an exposure that results from a person's acquisition, purchase, storage, consumption, or any reasonably foreseeable use of a consumer product, including consumption of a food." 27 CCR § 25600.1(d).
- 24. An exposure is knowing if the person or entity responsible for the exposure had or has "knowledge of the fact that . . . exposure to a chemical listed pursuant to Section 24249.8(a) of the Act is occurring." 27 CCR § 25102(n).
- 25. This Court has authority to enjoin "[a]ny person that violates or threatens to violate [Health & Safety Code § 25249.6]," and to impose civil penalties "not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) per day for each violation in addition to any other penalty established by law." Health & Safety Code § 25249.7. "Threaten to violate" is defined to mean "to create a condition in which there is a substantial probability that the violation will occur. Health and Safety Code § 25249.11((e).
- 26. Private parties are entitled to bring an action to enforce the Act under Health & Safety Code § 25249.7(d).

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

- 27. Plaintiff's testing at an independent laboratory demonstrates that the Covered Products contain lead and cadmium.
- 28. Since at least July 30, 2017, Defendants have produced, distributed, and/or sold the Covered Products in the State of California. The Covered Products are part of a line of meal replacement products under Defendants' brand name Huel.
- 29. Defendants have had knowledge that the Covered Products they produce, distribute, and/or sell in California contain lead and cadmium.
- 30. The primary route of exposure to lead and cadmium from Defendants' products is ingestion. This exposure to hazardous lead and cadmium results from the intended and reasonably foreseeable use of the Covered Products.

- Products as a "nutritionally complete food," and suggest that consumers "replace time-pressured, weekly meals like breakfast and lunch" with its products, including the Covered Products. The product display page of the Covered Products advertises the Covered Products as "Complete nutrition. Simply delivered." It also describes the Covered Products, under the heading "vitamins & minerals," as containing "[i]deal amounts of all the 27 essential vitamins and minerals," without disclosing that the Covered Products also contain lead and cadmium.
- 32. On Amazon.com, Defendants market the Covered Products as a "super convenient complete food." Under the "About the product" section on the Amazon.com product display page, Defendants state that the Covered Products "provides an optimum balance of proteins, carbs, essential fats, fiber and all 27 essential vitamins and minerals," but does not disclose that the Covered Products contain lead and cadmium.
- 33. On information and belief, since at least July 30, 2017, Defendants have produced, distributed, and/or sold the Covered Products within the State of California without providing a clear and reasonable warning, as required by the Toxic Enforcement Act, that the intended and reasonably foreseeable use of the Covered Products will result in consumers' exposure to a chemical known to the State of California to cause reproductive toxicity and birth defects ("Toxic Enforcement Act warning").
- 34. On information and belief, since at least February 22, 2019, Defendants have begun displaying a Toxic Enforcement Act warning in the form of a hyperlink with the text "WARNING: California Proposition 65" on the product display pages of the Covered Products

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on Defendants' own website, https://huel.com/. The warning text is not "clear and reasonable," as required by the Act, because it does not conform to the warning elements required by the applicable regulations, and because is not "display[ed] ... to the purchaser prior to completing the purchase." 27 CCR § 25602(b); id. at § 25603(a). A true and correct copy of 14 screenshots taken from Defendants' website as of March 28, 2019 are attached as Exhibit 1 to this Complaint.

- 35. The warning text is not prominently displayed to the purchaser prior to completing purchase of the Covered Products on Defendant's website. The hyperlink with the text "WARNING: California Proposition 65" appears only in one place: at the very bottom of the product display page. The hyperlink with warning text is not shown near the text box on the right side of the product display page where a consumer can immediately purchase the Covered Products, so one can purchase the products without ever seeing the warning. See Ex. 1, figs. 2-3. The hyperlink with the warning text is only displayed after scrolling through multiple sections: a product description section, a section displaying icons of media outlets where Huel's products have been featured, a section detailing "Benefits of Huel," and section containing a picture of a large Huel water bottle with surrounding texts advertising the products' various nutrients and ingredients, as well as claims about its health benefits. The hyperlink with warning text is only shown beneath two hyperlinked text boxes titled "Nutrition information" and "Ingredient information." See Ex. 1, figs. 2-5. The hyperlink with the warning text appears in a smaller font size than other headings and texts on the page. See Ex. 1, fig. 5. The warning text fails to bold the word "Warning," as required by 27 CCR § 25602(b). The words "Proposition 65" are added after "Warning." See Ex. 1, fig. 5. Moreover, a consumer may, and is likely to, purchase the product directly through an "add to cart" function on the first product screen they see without ever seeing the warning text. See Ex. 1, figs. 7-14.
- 36. On July 30, 2018, Plaintiff served Defendants with written notices of violation stating that Defendants had violated Proposition 65 by exposing individuals to lead and cadmium


in the Covered Products without providing a clear and reasonable warning. True and correct copies of Plaintiff's sixty-day notices are attached as Exhibit 2 to this Complaint.

- 37. Also on July 30, 2018, Plaintiff provided notice of the violation to the Attorney General and the district attorneys and city attorneys in whose jurisdiction the violations are alleged to have occurred.
- 38. Defendants have knowingly and intentionally exposed consumers to lead and cadmium. The exposure has been knowing and intentional because they result from Defendants' production, distribution and/or sale of the Covered Products that contain lead and cadmium, with knowledge that reasonably foreseeable use of the Covered Products will result in consumers' exposure to chemicals, namely lead and cadmium, known to the State of California to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
- 39. In accordance with Health and Safety Code section 25249.7(d), this action is being commenced more than 60 days from the date that As You Sow provided notice of the violation of Health and Safety Code section 25249.6 alleged herein to the Attorney General and the district attorneys and city attorneys in whose jurisdiction the violations are alleged to have occurred, and to Defendants. The notices provided to Defendants included certificates of merit that complied with the requirements of Health and Safety Code section 25249.7(d)(1). Factual information sufficient to establish the basis of the certificate of merit was attached to the certificate of merit served on the Attorney General.
- 40. Neither the Attorney General, any district attorney, any city attorney, nor any other public prosecutor has commenced and is diligently prosecuting an action against the violations alleged herein.




- Plaintiff re-alleges and incorporates by reference all the allegations set forth in this Complaint.
- 42. By committing the acts alleged above, Defendants have, in the course of doing business, knowingly and intentionally exposed individuals to chemicals known to the State of







Figure 10. Huel's shopping cart page (cont'd) - no Proposition 65 warning III Apps 🔀 AYS Slack 🗗 AYS Mail 🚾 AYS Box **Huel**° \$33.00 action. amagon pay # PayPal \$33.00 Contact information Total Including \$2.87 in taxes so \$33.00 Keep me up to date on news and exclusive offers Shipping address First name Last name Apartment, suite, etc. (optional)



As You Sow ("AYS") is a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation dedicated to, among other causes, toxics reduction, the promotion of and improvement of human health, the improvement of worker and consumer rights, environmental education and the protection of the environment, and corporate accountability. AYS is based in Oakland, California, and was incorporated in 1992 under the laws of the State of California.

AYS has documented violations of California's Safe Drinking Water & Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 ("Proposition 65"), codified at Health & Safety Code section 25249.5 et seq. This letter serves to provide AYS' notification of these violations to Huel Limited, the violator. Pursuant to section 25249.7(d) of the statute, AYS intends to bring an enforcement action sixty days after effective service of this notice unless the public enforcement agencies have commenced and are diligently prosecuting an action to rectify these violations.

A summary of the statute and its implementing regulations, which was prepared by the lead agency designated under the statute, is enclosed with the notices served upon the violators. The specific details of the violations that are the subject of this notice are provided below.

Alleged violator(s). The name of the violator covered by this notice is:

• Huel Limited

Chemicals. The violations involve exposures to lead and/or cadmium from the products listed below. The State of California has officially listed lead and cadmium as chemicals known to cause birth defects or reproductive harm. See Chemicals Known to the State to Cause Cancer or Reproductive Toxicity, available at http://oehha.ca.gov/prop65/prop65_list/Newlist.html.

Consumer products. The products that are the subject of this notice are nutritional, protein, or meal replacement powder or drink that contain lead and/or cadmium and are, at any time, manufactured, distributed, or sold by the alleged violators, including but not limited to the following:

• Huel, Vanilla Flavor, which is manufactured, distributed and/or sold in California by Huel Limited or Huel Inc.

Route of exposure. Use of the products identified in this notice result in human exposures to lead and cadmium. The route of exposure is ingestion. No clear and reasonable warning is provided with the products regarding the reproductive hazards of lead or cadmium.

Duration of violation. These ongoing violations have occurred on every day since at least July 30, 2017, as well as every day since the products were introduced in the California marketplace, and will continue every day until clear and reasonable warnings are provided to product purchasers and users or until these known toxic chemicals are removed from the products.

Pursuant to Title 11, Cal. Code Regs. section 3100, a certificate of merit is attached hereto.

In keeping with its public interest mission and to expeditiously rectify this ongoing violation of California law, AYS is interested in seeking a constructive resolution of this matter without engaging in costly and protracted litigation.
