14	Plaintiff Precila Balabbo ("Plaintiff"), by and through her attorneys, alleges the following		
15	cause of action in the public interest of the citizens of the State of California.		
16	BACKGROUND OF THE CASE		
17	1. Plaintiff brings this representative action on behalf of all California citizens to		
18	enforce relevant portions of Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, codified at		
19	the Health and Safety Code § 25249.5 et seq ("Proposition 65"), which reads, in relevant part,		
20	"[n]o person in the course of doing business shall knowingly and intentionally expose any		
21	individual to a chemical known to the state to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity without first		
22	giving clear and reasonable warning to such individual". Health & Safety Code § 25249.6.		
23	2. This complaint is a representative action brought by Plaintiff in the public interest		
24	of the citizens of the State of California to enforce the People's right to be informed of the health		
25	hazards caused by exposure to chromium (hexavalent compounds) ("CrVI"), lead, and/or		CrVI"), lead, and/or
26	diethanolamine ("DEA"), toxic chemicals found in products sold and/or distributed by defendant		ributed by defendant
27	The TJX Companies, Inc. ("TJX" or "Defendant") in California.

- 3. CrVI<sup>1</sup> and lead<sup>2</sup> are harmful chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm. DEA<sup>3</sup> is a harmful chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer.
- 4. Proposition 65 requires all businesses with ten (10) or more employees that operate within California or sell products therein to comply with Proposition 65 regulations. Included in such regulations is the requirement that businesses must label any product containing a Proposition 65-listed chemical that will create an exposure above safe harbor levels with a "clear and reasonable" warning before "knowingly and intentionally" exposing any person to any such listed chemical.
- 5. Proposition 65 allows for civil penalties of up to \$2,500.00 per day per violation for up to 365 days (up to a maximum civil penalty amount per violation of \$912,000.00) to be imposed upon defendants in a civil action for violations of Proposition 65. Health & Safety Code \$ 25249.7(b). Proposition 65 also allows for any court of competent jurisdiction to enjoin the actions of a defendant which "violate or threaten to violate" the statute. Health & Safety Code \$ 25249.7.
- 6. Plaintiff alleges that Defendant distributes and/or offers for sale in California, without a requisite exposure warning, (a) Newton Buying Corp. leather handbags, RN # 75343 (CrVI), (b) *Sincerely Nuts*® lightly sweetened dried unsulfured mango slices, UPC # 850009366658, (lead), (c) El Almendro almond pumpkin seed and dark chocolate protein bars,

UPC # 8410223909592, (lead), (d) genuine leather hand crafted India wallets, RN # 75343, (CrVI), (e) PaperProducts gift set with glass tea pots, UPC # 4021766237468, (lead), (f) *Home Essentials* <sup>TM</sup> lemons & leaves tea pots, UPC # 786460927773, (lead), (g) ceramic frog figurines, Style # 273879, (lead), and (h) *Pause* <sup>TM</sup> *Well Aging* <sup>TM</sup> discovery kit collagen boosting moisturizers, UPC # 850005029100, (DEA) (collectively, the "Products" and each a "Product") that expose persons to CrVI, lead, and/or DEA when used for their intended purpose.

- 7. Defendant's failure to warn consumers and other individuals in California of the health hazards associated with exposure to CrVI, lead, and/or DEA in conjunction with the sale and/or distribution of the Products is a violation of Proposition 65 and subjects Defendant to the enjoinment and civil penalties described herein.
- 8. Plaintiff seeks civil penalties against Defendant for its violations of Proposition 65 in accordance with Health and Safety Code § 25249.7(b).
- 9. Plaintiff also seeks injunctive relief, preliminarily and permanently, requiring Defendant to provide purchasers, users, or consumers of the Products with required warnings related to the dangers and health hazards associated with exposure to CrVI, lead, and/or DEA pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 25249.7(a).
  - 10. Plaintiff further seeks a reasonable award of attorney's fees and costs.

### **PARTIES**

- 11. Plaintiff is a citizen of the State of California acting in the interest of the general public to promote awareness of exposures to toxic chemicals in products sold in California and to improve human health by reducing hazardous substances contained in such items. She brings this action in the public interest pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 25249.7(d).
- 12. Defendant The TJX Companies, Inc., through its business, effectively imports, distributes, sells, and/or offers the Products for sale or use in the State of California, or it implies by its conduct that it imports, distributes, sells, and/or offers the Products for sale or use in the State of California. Plaintiff alleges that defendant The TJX Companies, Inc. is a "person" in the course of doing business within the meaning of Health & Safety Code sections 25249.6 and 25249.11.

## **VENUE AND JURISDICTION**

- 13. Venue is proper in the County of San Francisco because one or more of the instances of wrongful conduct occurred, and continue to occur in this county and/or because Defendant conducted, and continues to conduct, business in the County of San Francisco with respect to the Products.
- 14. This Court has jurisdiction over this action pursuant to California Constitution Article VI, § 10, which grants the Superior Court original jurisdiction in all causes except those given by statute to other trial courts. Health and Safety Code § 25249.7 allows for the enforcement of violations of Proposition 65 in any Court of competent jurisdiction; therefore, this Court has jurisdiction over this lawsuit.
- 15. This Court has jurisdiction over Defendant because Defendant is either a citizen of the State of California, has sufficient minimum contacts with the State of California, is registered with the California Secretary of State as foreign corporations authorized to do business in the State of California, and/or has otherwise purposefully availed itself of the California market. Such purposeful availment has rendered the exercise of jurisdiction by California courts consistent and permissible with traditional notions of fair play and substantial justice.

# **STATUTORY BACKGROUND**

- 16. The people of the State of California declared in Proposition 65 their right "[t]o be informed about exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm." (Section 1(b) of Initiative Measure, Proposition 65.)
- 17. To effect this goal, Proposition 65 requires that individuals be provided with a "clear and reasonable warning" before being exposed to substances listed by the State of California as causing cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm. H&S Code § 25249.6 states, in pertinent part:

No person in the course of doing business shall knowingly and intentionally expose any individual to a chemical known to the state to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity without first giving clear and reasonable warning to such individual...

18. An exposure to a chemical in a consumer product is one "which results from a person's acquisition, purchase, storage, consumption or other reasonably foreseeable use of a consumer good, or any exposure that results from receiving a consumer service." (27 CCR § 25602, para (b).) H&S Code § 25603(c) states that "a person in the course of doing business ... shall provide a warning to any person to whom the product is sold or transferred unless the product is packaged or labeled with a clear and reasonable warning."

- 19. Pursuant to H&S Code § 25603.1, the warning may be provided by using one or more of the following methods individually or in combination:<sup>4</sup>
  - a. A warning that appears on a product's label or other labeling.
  - b. Identification of the product at the retail outlet in a manner which provides a warning. Identification may be through shelf labeling, signs, menus, or a combination thereof.
  - c. The warnings provided pursuant to subparagraphs (a) and (b) shall be prominently placed upon a product's labels or other labeling or displayed at the retail outlet with such conspicuousness, as compared with other words, statements, designs, or devices in the label, labeling or display as to render it likely to be read and understood by an ordinary individual under customary conditions of purchase or use.
  - d. A system of signs, public advertising identifying the system and toll-free information services, or any other system that provides clear and reasonable warnings.
- 20. Proposition 65 provides that any "person who violates or threatens to violate" the statute may be enjoined in a court of competent jurisdiction. (H&S Code § 25249.7.) The phrase "threaten to violate" is defined to mean creating "a condition in which there is a substantial probability that a violation will occur." (H&S Code § 25249.11(e).) Violators are liable for civil

penalties of up to \$2,500.00 per day for each violation of the Act (H&S Code § 25249.7) for up to 365 days (up to a maximum civil penalty amount per violation of \$912,000.00).

## **FACTUAL BACKGROUND**

- 21. On June 22, 2012, the State of California listed DEA as a chemical known to the State to cause cancer and it has come under the purview of Proposition 65 regulations since that time. Cal. Code Regs. Tit. 27, § 27001(c); Health & Safety Code §§ 25249.8 & 25249.10(b).
- 22. On October 1, 1992, the state of California listed lead as a chemical known to cause cancer and it has come under the purview of Proposition 65 regulations since that time. Cal. Code Regs. Tit. 27, § 27001(c); Health & Safety Code §§ 25249.8 & 25249.10(b). On February 27, 1987, the State of California listed lead as a chemical known to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
- 23. On February 27, 1987, the State of California listed chromium (VI) as a chemical known to the State to cause cancer and it has come under the purview of Proposition 65 regulations since that time. Cal. Code Regs. Tit. 27, § 27001(c); Health & Safety Code §§ 25249.8 & 25249.10(b). On December 19, 2008, the State of California listed chromium (VI) as a chemical known to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
- 24. The exposures that are the subject of the Notices result from the purchase, acquisition, handling, consumption, and recommended use of the Products. The primary route of exposure to lead in ceramic products, CrvI, and/or DEA is through dermal absorption directly through the skin when consumers use, touch, or handle the Products. Exposure through ingestion will occur by touching the Products with subsequent touching of the user's hand to mouth. The primary route of exposure to lead in food products is through ingestion. When foods contaminated with lead are consumed, ingestion of lead will occur which will increase blood lead levels. No clear and reasonable warning is provided with the Products regarding the health hazards of exposure.
- 25. Defendant has processed, marketed, distributed, offered to sell and/or sold the Products in California since at least August 7, 2023 with respect to the Newton Buying Corp. leather handbags; since at least August 16, 2023 with respect to the *Sincerely Nuts®* lightly

sweetened dried unsulfured mango slices and the El Almendro almond pumpkin seed and dark chocolate protein bars; since at least August 31, 2023 with respect to the genuine leather hand crafted India wallets; since at least October 9, 2023 with respect to the PaperProducts gift set with glass tea pots and the *Home Essentials*<sup>TM</sup> lemons & leaves tea pots; since at least February 16, 2024 with respect to the ceramic frog figurines; and since at least February 26, 2024 with respect to the *Pause*<sup>TM</sup> *Well Aging*<sup>TM</sup> discovery kit collagen boosting moisturizers. The Products continue to be distributed and sold in California without the requisite warning information.

- 26. At all times relevant to this action, Defendant has knowingly and intentionally exposed users and/or consumers of the Products to CrVI, lead, and/or DEA without first giving a clear and reasonable exposure warning to such individuals.
- 27. As a proximate result of acts by Defendant, as a person in the course of doing business within the meaning of H&S Code § 25249.11, individuals throughout the State of California, including in San Francisco County, have been exposed to CrVI, lead, and/or DEA without a clear and reasonable warning on the Products. The individuals subject to the violative exposures include normal and foreseeable users and consumers that use the Products, as well as all others exposed to the Products.

# **SATISFACTION OF NOTICE REQUIREMNTS**

- 28. Plaintiff purchased the Products from TJX. At the time of purchase, Defendant did not provide a Proposition 65 exposure warning for CrVI, lead, DEA, or any other Proposition 65 listed chemical in a manner consistent with H&S Code § 25603.1 as described *supra*.
- The Pause™ Well Aging™ discovery kit collagen boosting moisturizers were sent to a testing laboratory for diethanolamine testing to determine the DEA content of the Product; the Sincerely Nuts® lightly sweetened dried unsulfured mango slices and the El Almendro almond pumpkin seed and dark chocolate protein bars were sent to a testing laboratory to determine if, and what amount of, lead a consumer would be exposed to per serving size; the PaperProducts gift set with glass tea pots, the Home Essentials™ lemons & leaves tea pots, and the ceramic frog figurines were sent to a testing laboratory to determine if, and what amount of, lead would migrate and/or leach from the Products; and the Newton Buying Corp. leather handbags and the genuine leather

hand crafted India wallets were sent to a CrVI laboratory to determine the CrVI content from the Products.

- 30. For each Product that was sent to the laboratory, Plaintiff received a chemical test report (collectively, the "Chemical Test Reports" and each a "Chemical Test Report"). The Chemical Test Reports findings determined the *Sincerely Nuts*® lightly sweetened dried unsulfured mango slices, the El Almendro almond pumpkin seed and dark chocolate protein bars, the PaperProducts gift set with glass tea pots, the *Home Essentials*™ lemons & leaves tea pots, and the ceramic frog figurines expose users and/or consumers to lead; the Newton Buying Corp. leather handbags and the genuine leather hand crafted India wallets; and the *Pause*™ *Well Aging*™ discovery kit collagen boosting moisturizers expose users to DEA.
- 31. Plaintiff provided each Chemical Test Report and each Product to an analytical chemist to determine if, based on the findings of the Chemical Test Reports and the reasonable and foreseeable use of the Products, exposure to CrVI, lead, and/or DEA will occur at levels that require Proposition 65 warnings under the Clear and Reasonable Warnings section 25601 of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations.
- 32. On August 7, 2023, Plaintiff received from the analytical chemist an exposure assessment report for the Newton Buying Corp. leather handbags that concluded that persons in California who use the Newton Buying Corp. leather handbags will be exposed to levels of CrVI that require a Proposition 65 exposure warning. On August 16, 2023, Plaintiff received from the analytical chemist exposure assessment reports for the *Sincerely Nuts®* lightly sweetened dried unsulfured mango slices and the El Almendro almond pumpkin seed and dark chocolate protein bars that concluded that persons in California who consume the *Sincerely Nuts®* lightly sweetened dried unsulfured mango slices and the El Almendro almond pumpkin seed and dark chocolate protein bars will be exposed to levels of lead that require a Proposition 65 exposure warning. On August 31, 2023, Plaintiff received from the analytical chemist an exposure assessment report for the genuine leather hand crafted India wallets that concluded that persons in California who use the genuine leather hand crafted India wallets will be exposed to levels of CrVI that require a Proposition 65 exposure warning. On October 9, 2023, Plaintiff received from the analytical

chemist an exposure assessment report for the PaperProducts gift set with glass tea pots and the *Home Essentials*<sup>TM</sup> lemons & leaves tea pots that concluded that persons in California who use the PaperProducts gift set with glass tea pots and the *Home Essentials*<sup>TM</sup> lemons & leaves tea pots will be exposed to levels of lead that require a Proposition 65 exposure warning. On February 16, 2024, Plaintiff received from the analytical chemist an exposure assessment report for the ceramic frog figurines that concluded that persons in California who use the ceramic frog figurines will be exposed to levels of lead that require a Proposition 65 exposure warning. On February 26, 2024, Plaintiff received from the analytical chemist an exposure assessment report for the *Pause*<sup>TM</sup> *Well Aging*<sup>TM</sup> discovery kit collagen boosting moisturizers that concluded that persons in California who use the *Pause*<sup>TM</sup> *Well Aging*<sup>TM</sup> discovery kit collagen boosting moisturizers will be exposed to levels of DEA that require a Proposition 65 exposure warning.

- 33. On August 7, 2023 (Newton Buying Corp. leather handbags), August 16, 2023 (Sincerely Nuts® lightly sweetened dried unsulfured mango slices and El Almendro almond pumpkin seed and dark chocolate protein bars), August 31, 2023 (genuine leather hand crafted India wallets), October 9, 2023 (PaperProducts gift set with glass tea pots and Home Essentials™ lemons & leaves tea pots), February 16, 2024 (ceramic frog figurines), and February 26, 2024 (Pause™ Well Aging™ discovery kit collagen boosting moisturizers), Plaintiff gave notice of alleged violation of Health and Safety Code § 25249.6 (collectively, the "Notices" and each a "Notice") to Defendant concerning the exposure of California citizens to CrVI, lead, and/or DEA contained in the Products without proper warning, subject to a private action to Defendant and to the California Attorney General's office and the offices of the County District attorneys and City Attorneys for each city with a population greater than 750,000 persons wherein the herein violations allegedly occurred. See attached at Exhibits "A" "H" a true and correct copy of the Notices.
- 34. The Notices complied with all procedural requirements of Proposition 65 including the attachment of a Certificate of Merit affirming that Plaintiff's counsel had consulted with at least one person with relevant and appropriate expertise who reviewed relevant data regarding

CrVI, lead, and/or DEA exposure, and that counsel believed there was meritorious and reasonable cause for a private action.

- 35. After receiving the Notices, and to Plaintiff's best information and belief, none of the noticed appropriate public enforcement agencies have commenced and diligently prosecuted a cause of action against Defendant under Proposition 65 to enforce the alleged violations which are the subject of the Notices.
- 36. Plaintiff is commencing this action more than sixty (60) days from the date of each Notice to Defendant, as required by law

## **FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION**

# (By Plaintiff against Defendant for the Violation of Proposition 65)

- 37. Plaintiff hereby repeats and incorporates by reference paragraphs 1 through 37 of this Complaint as though fully set forth herein.
- 38. Defendant has, at all times mentioned herein, acted as distributer, and/or retailer of the Products.
- 39. Use of the Products will expose users to CrVI, lead, and/or DEA, hazardous chemicals found on the Proposition 65 list of chemicals known to be hazardous to human health.
  - 40. The Products do not comply with the Proposition 65 warning requirements.
- 41. Plaintiff, based on her best information and belief, avers that at all relevant times herein, and since at least August 7, 2023 with respect to the Newton Buying Corp. leather handbags; since at least August 16, 2023 with respect to the *Sincerely Nuts*® lightly sweetened dried unsulfured mango slices and the El Almendro almond pumpkin seed and dark chocolate protein bars; since at least August 31, 2023 with respect to the genuine leather hand crafted India wallets; since at least October 9, 2023 with respect to the PaperProducts gift set with glass tea pots and the *Home Essentials* TM lemons & leaves tea pots; since at least February 16, 2024 with respect to the ceramic frog figurines; and since at least February 26, 2024 with respect to the *Pause* TM *Well Aging* TM discovery kit collagen boosting moisturizers, continuing until the present, that Defendant has continued to knowingly and intentionally expose California users and consumers of the Products to CrVI, lead, and/or DEA without providing required warnings under Proposition 65.

- 42. The exposures that are the subject of the Notices result from the purchase, acquisition, handling, consumption, and recommended use of the Products. The primary route of exposure to lead in ceramic products, CrVI, and/or DEA is through dermal absorption directly through the skin when consumers use, touch, or handle the Products. Exposure through ingestion will occur by touching the Products with subsequent touching of the user's hand to mouth. The primary route of exposure to lead in food products is through ingestion. When foods contaminated with lead are consumed, ingestion of lead will occur which will increase blood lead levels. No clear and reasonable warning is provided with the Products regarding the health hazards of exposure.
- 43. Plaintiff, based on her best information and belief, avers that such exposures will continue every day until clear and reasonable warnings are provided to purchasers and users or until these known toxic chemicals are removed from the Products.
- 44. Defendant has knowledge that the normal and reasonably foreseeable use of the Products expose individuals to CrVI, lead, and/or DEA, and Defendant intends that exposures to CrVI, lead, and/or DEA will occur by its deliberate, non-accidental participation in the importation, distribution, sale and offering of the Products to consumers in California.
- 45. Plaintiff has engaged in good faith efforts to resolve the herein claims prior to this Complaint.
- 46. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 25249.7(b), as a consequence of the above described acts, Defendant is liable for a maximum civil penalty of \$2,500 per day per violation.
- 47. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 25249.7(a), this Court is specifically authorized to grant injunctive relief in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant.

## **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff demands judgment against Defendant and requests the following

- A. That the court assess civil penalties against Defendant in the amount of \$2,500 per day for each violation for up to 365 days (up to a maximum civil penalty amount per violation of \$912,000.00) in accordance with Health and Safety Code § 25249.7(b);
- B. That the court preliminarily and permanently enjoin Defendant mandating Proposition 65 compliant warnings on the Products;
- C. That the court grant Plaintiff reasonable attorney's fees and costs of suit, in the amount of \$50,000.00.
- D. That the court grant any further relief as may be just and proper.

# 60-Day Notice of Violation of California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act1

To Whom It May Concern:

This Notice of Violation (the "Notice") is provided to you pursuant to and in compliance with California Health & Safety Code § 25249.7(d).

Brodsky Smith represents Precila Balabbo ("Balabbo"), a citizen of the State of California acting in the interest of the general public to promote awareness of exposures to toxic chemicals from use of consumer products sold in California and to improve human health and the environment by reducing hazardous substances.
