
JUDGMENT PURSUANT TO TERMS

The Court approves the Stipulation filed on April 6, 2007 with those minor amendments, and the Court's Order approving the Proposition 65 Settlement on April 5, 2007 is deemed applicable to that Stipulation with its two minor amendments.)
