The Court finds that the settlement agreement attached to the [Proposed] Judgment Pursuant to Terms of Consent Judgment and [Proposed] Order Pursuant to Terms of Stipulation and Order Re: Consent Judgment meets the criteria established by Health & Safety Code section 25249.7, in that: (A) the health hazard warning required by the Stipulation complies with Health & Safety Code section 25249.6; (B) the reimbursement of fees and costs to be paid pursuant to the Stipulation is reasonable under California law; and (C) the civil penalty amount to be paid pursuant to the Stipulation is reasonable based on the criteria set forth in section 25249.7(b)(2).

Accordingly, the Court will sign and enter the [Proposed] Judgment Pursuant to Terms of Consent Judgment submitted to the Court with the motion, with the Settlement Agreement to be attached as Exhibit A thereto.


