AGAINST LAWSON INDUSTRIES, INC.

1 Pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure Section 585, the Court hereby enters final
2 judgment in favor of plaintiff Russell Brimer and against defendant Lawson Industries, Inc. as
3 follows:

4 1. Lawson Industries, Inc. is permanently enjoined from offering any tape measures
5 made from materials containing Lead for sale in California or to any California retailer without
6 providing a clear and reasonable warning of the carcinogenic and reproductive harm associated
7 with Lead, pursuant to Health & Safety Code Section 25249.7(a);


8 2. Lawson Industries, Inc. is ordered to pay \$69,480.00 in statutory civil penalties,
9 pursuant to Health & Safety Code Section 25249.7(b);

10 3. Lawson Industries, Inc. is ordered to pay \$37,213.50 to The Chanler Group as
11 reimbursement of reasonable attorney fees pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Section 1021.5
12 and is also ordered to pay The Chanler Group \$994.88 as reimbursement of its reasonable costs.

13 4. All payment amounts required pursuant to Paragraphs 2 and 3 of this Default
14 Judgment are due within thirty (30) days of entry of this Default Judgment. These amounts shall
15 be paid to Brimer's attorneys by check payable to "The Chanler Group" and shall be sent to The
16 Chanler Group at 2560 Ninth Street, Suite 214, Berkeley, California, 94710.

17 IT IS SO ORDERED.
