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1	Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 585, the Court hereby enters final judgment in
2	favor of plaintiff Whitney R. Leeman, Ph.D. against defendant Decor Craft Inc. as follows:
3	1. Decor Craft Inc. is permanently enjoined from offering any tools with vinyl/PVC
4	grips containing di(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) in California without first providing clear and
5	reasonable warnings regarding the risks of birth defects or other reproductive harm caused by
6	Exposures to DEHP, as required by Health and Safety Code section 25249.7(a). This includes but i
7	not limited to the DCI Extend Light + Magnet, Item# 30956, UPC #8 19401 03095 6, identified in
8	the Complaint.
9	2. Decor Craft Inc. is ordered to pay \$2,500 in statutory penalties, pursuant to Health
10	and Safety Code section 25249.7(b);
11	3. Decor Craft Inc. is ordered to pay \$31,164.91 in costs and attorneys' fees to plaintiff
12	as reimbursement of her reasonable attorneys' fees pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section
13	1021.5.
14	4. All amounts required by paragraphs 2 and 3 of this Default Judgment are due within
15	thirty days of the date of entry of this Default Judgment. These amounts shall be paid to plaintiff's
