 20 to the terms of the settlement memorialized in the [Proposed] Code of Civil Procedure Section  
 21 664.6 Settlement attached as Exhibit A to the Declaration of Evan J. Smith in Support of Motion


1. The injunctive relief required by the Code of Civil Procedure Section 664.6 Settlement as to Defendant Protective Industrial Products, Inc. complies with Proposition 65;
2. The reimbursement of fees and costs provided by the Code of Civil Procedure Section 664.6 Settlement as to Defendant Protective Industrial Products, Inc. is reasonable under California law; and
3. The civil penalty amount to be paid pursuant to the Code of Civil Procedure Section 664.6 Settlement as to Defendant Protective Industrial Products, Inc. is reasonable.

Accordingly, the Motion for Approval of the Code of Civil Procedure Section 664.6 Settlement as to Defendant Protective Industrial Products, Inc. is GRANTED.

Plaintiff may file a Request for Dismissal pursuant to the agreement; if the matter is now dismissed the court will retain jurisdiction to enforce the settlement agreement into which the parties have entered to settle this matter.
