On April 3, 2019 at 8:30 a.m., Plaintiff Shefa LMV Inc.'s ("Plaintiff") Motion for Court Approval and Entry of Consent Judgment as to Defendant The NCC NY LLC came for hearing before this Court in Department 62, the Honorable Michael L. Stern presiding. Plaintiff was [not] present; Defendant was [not] present. After full consideration of the points and authorities and related pleadings submitted, the Court rules as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion for Approval of Entry of Consent Judgment is GRANTED.
