5 Court rules as follows:


6 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion for Approval of Entry of Consent

10 the following findings with respect to the Consent Judgment between Plaintiff Shefa LMV Inc. and
11 Defendant The NCC NY LLC.

- 12 1. The Consent Judgment ensures compliance with the Proposition 65 warning requirement;
13 2. The attorneys' fee award in the Consent Judgment is reasonable under California law; and
14 3. The civil penalty and payment in lieu of civil penalty in the Consent Judgment is reasonable
15 based on the criteria listed in Health & Safety Code §25249.7(b)(2).
