 - Commencing ten days after service upon Defendant 2020 Apparel, Inc. of the Notice of Entry of this Order and Default Judgment, Defendant 2020 Apparel, Inc. is ORDERED to not directly manufacture, import, distribute, sell, or offer for sale in California any *Simply You Clear Plastic Tote Bags 12HNBG9008 1705030003* (the "Product(s)") that are not Di2(2-thylhexyll) phthalate ("DEHP")-Free (hereinafter "Reformulated Products") unless the Product is accompanied by a warning that complies with Article 6 of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations provide clear and reasonable warnings as set forth below. The warning shall be prominently placed with such conspicuousness as compared with other words, statements, designs, or devices as to render it likely to be read and understood by an ordinary individual under customary conditions before purchase or use. The warning shall be provided in a manner such that the consumer or user understands to which specific Product the warning applies, so as to minimize the risk of consumer confusions, and shall be issued as follows:
 - a. For any Product shipped, sold, or offered in California by Defendant 2020 Apparel, Inc. that is not DEHP-Free, one of the following warnings shall accompany the Products: (a) WARNING: This product can expose you to chemicals including Di2(2-thylhexyll) phthalate (DEHP), which is known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm. For more information go to www.P65Warnings.ca.gov; or (b) WARNING: Cancer and Reproductive Harm www.P65Warnings.ca.gov. The warning that is provided must print the word "WARNING:" in all capital letters and in bold font, followed by a colon. The warning symbol to the left of the word "WARNING:" must be a black exclamation point in a yellow equilateral triangle with a black outline, except that if the sign or label for the

Products does not use the color yellow, the symbol may be in black and white. The symbol must be in a size no smaller than the height of the word "WARNING:". The warning shall be affixed to or printed on the Products' packaging or labeling, or on a placard, shelf tag, sign or electronic device or automatic process, providing that the warning is displayed with such conspicuousness, as compared with other words, statements, or designs as to render it likely to be read and understood by an ordinary individual under customary conditions of purchase or use. A warning may be contained in the same section of the packaging, labeling, or instruction booklet that states other safety warnings, if any, concerning the use of the Product and shall be at least the same size as those other safety warnings;

b. If Defendant 2020 Apparel, Inc. sells Products via an internet website to customers located in California, the warning requirements of this section shall be satisfied if the foregoing warning appears either: (a) on the same web page on which a Product is displayed and/or described; (b) on the same page as the price for the Product; or (c) on one or more web pages displayed to a purchaser prior to purchase during the checkout process. Alternatively, a symbol consisting of a black exclamation point in a yellow or white equilateral triangle may appear adjacent to or immediately following the display, description, price, or checkout listing of the Product, if the warning statement appears elsewhere on the same web page in a manner that clearly associates it with the product(s) to which the warning applies.
