1 In the above-entitled action, Keep America Safe and Beautiful and Defendant Northern
2 Wholesale Supply, Inc. dba Extreme Max, have agreed to the terms of the mutually executed
3 settlement memorialized in the [Proposed] Consent Judgment ("Consent Judgment"), attached as
4 ~~Exhibit A~~ to the Declaration of Laralei Paras in Support of Motion to Approve Proposition 65
5 Settlement and Consent Judgment lodged herewith, and plaintiff has moved this Court for an
6 Order approving the settlement.

7 After consideration of the papers submitted and the arguments presented, the Court finds
8 that the settlement agreement set forth in the Consent Judgment meets the criteria established by
9 California Health & Safety Code § 25249.7(f)(4), in that:

- 10 1. The injunctive relief required by the Consent Judgment complies with Proposition
11 65;
- 12 2. The reimbursement of fees and costs provided by the Consent Judgment is
13 reasonable under California law; and
- 14 3. The civil penalty amount to be paid pursuant to the Consent Judgment is
15 reasonable.

16 ~~Plaintiff's~~ Accordingly, the Motion for Approval of the Proposition 65 Settlement was not opposed
17 and is GRANTED.
