[PROPOSED] DEFAULT JUDGMENT AGAINST DEFENDANT MCCAULOU'S, INC.

Defendant Treska, Inc. was dismissed from this action on September 2, 2022, with prejudice. In conjunction with the determination and entry of this default Judgment, plaintiff has stipulated to dismiss all remaining defendants, DOE 1 through DOE 150, without prejudice and this Court therefore orders dismissal of all DOE defendants from this action without prejudice.

Defendant McCaulou's, Inc. failed to appear or otherwise defend in this action and its default was entered on June 14, 2022. Upon application of plaintiff, though affidavit and evidence, it appears plaintiff Susan Davia is entitled to judgment against McCaulou's, Inc.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that said Susan Davia shall have and recover from defendant McCaulou's, Inc. the sum of \$2,500 as reasonable statutory penalties pursuant to H&S Code Section 25249.7(b), with interest thereon at the rate of

ten percent (10%) per annum from the date of this judgment, seventy-five percent (75%) of which 1 civil penalty shall be forwarded to the California Office of Health Hazard Assessment. 2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that said Susan Davia shall have 3 and recover from defendant McCaulou's, Inc. the sum of \$160 as reasonable attorney fees 4 and costs pursuant to C.C.P. Section 1021.5, with interest thereon at the rate of ten percent (10%) 5 per annum from the date of this judgment. 6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that defendant McCaulou's, Inc. 7 shall be subject to permanent injunction precluding California distribution or sale of any style or 8 pattern of Treska vinyl accessory tote bag products unless the product is accompanied with the 9 10 following warning: ⚠ WARNING: The vinyl materials of this product can 11 expose you to chemicals, including DINP, that are known to the State of California to cause cancer.
