


29 Plaintiff Mateel Environmental Justice Foundation's unopposed Motion To Approve  
30 Proposition 65 Settlement And for Entry of Consent Judgment is GRANTED.

31 Good cause appearing, Plaintiff's motion to approve settlement pursuant to Health and  
32 Safety Code section 25249.7(f) and Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6 is granted. Based on  
33 the record before it, the court finds: (1) the injunctive relief required by the settlement complies

1 with Proposition 65; (2) the penalty amounts are reasonable based on the criteria set forth in  
2 Health and Safety Code section 25249.7(b)(2); and, (3) the award of attorney's fees is reasonable  
3 under California law. The consent judgments shall be entered consistent with the Proposition 65  
4 Settlement and the Parties' [Proposed] Consent Judgment.
