1 Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure § 585, the Court hereby enters final judgment in favor of
2 plaintiff Keep America Safe and Beautiful (“KASB”) against defendant Jiffy Steamer Company,
3 LLC (“Jiffy Steamer”) as follows:

4 1. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 25249.7(a), Jiffy Steamer is permanently
5 enjoined from offering any accessories with brass components containing the heavy metal, Lead, in
6 California without providing clear and reasonable warnings regarding the risks of cancer and birth
7 defects or other reproductive harm caused by Lead exposures, as set forth in paragraph 2 below.
8 This includes but is not limited to *Jiffy Steamer Plastic Head, Hose and Handle, SKU 2136*.

9 2. The warning provided pursuant to this Judgment shall state:

10 **⚠WARNING [OR] CALIFORNIA WARNING [OR] CA WARNING:**
11 This product can expose you to Lead, which is known to the State of
12 California to cause cancer and birth defect or other reproductive harm. For
13 more information go to www.P65warnings.gov.

14 The above language should be placed conspicuously on all accessories with brass components
15 which contain detectable amounts of Lead or the product packaging.

16 3. Jiffy Steamer is ordered to pay \$5,000 in statutory penalties, pursuant to Health and
17 Safety Code § 25249.7(b);

18 4. Jiffy Steamer is ordered to pay \$14,091 in attorneys’ fees to KASB as reimbursement
19 of reasonable attorneys’ fees pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 1021.5. In addition, Jiffy
20 Steamer is ordered to pay \$6,004.37 in costs.

21 5. All amounts required by paragraphs 3 and 4 of this Default Judgment are due within
22 thirty days of the date of entry of this Default Judgment and shall be sent to Seven Hills LLP, 1
23 Embarcadero Center, Suite 1200, San Francisco, CA 94111.

24 Jiffy Steamer’s civil penalty payment will be allocated according to Health and Safety Code
25 §§ 25249.12(c)(1) and (d), with seventy-five percent (75%) of the penalty paid to the California
26 Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (“OEHHA”), and the remaining twenty-five
27 percent (25%) retained by KASB. Jiffy Steamer shall issue its payment in two checks made
28 payable to: (a) “OEHHA” in the amount of \$3,750; and (b) “Seven Hills LLP in Trust for KASB”
in the amount of \$1,250. KASB’s counsel shall deliver to OEHHA and KASB their respective
portion of the penalty payment.

1 The attorneys' fees and costs payments shall be combined in a single check in the amount of
2 \$20,095.37 made payable to "Seven Hills LLP."
