INTRODUCTION

My name is Michael DiPirro. I am a citizen of California and a private party acting in the interest of the general public who seeks to promote awareness of exposures to toxic chemicals and improve human health by reducing or eliminating hazardous substances contained in or produced by consumer and industrial products. This letter is provided to you pursuant to Health & Safety Code §25249.6 et seq ("Proposition 65"). As required, notice is also being provided to the violators, Dansk International Designs and J.C. Penney Company, Inc. (Violators"). The violations covered by this notice consist of the routes of exposures to the following toxic chemical:

CHEMICAL

1. Lead (or lead compounds)

ROUTES OF EXPOSURE

Ingestion, Dermal

NATURE OF ALLEGED VIOLATION (PRODUCT EXPOSURE)

The specific type(s) of products that are causing *consumer* and occupational exposures in violation of Proposition 65 (and are covered by this notice) is listed below in section Exhibit A. The Violators' sales of these products have been occurring from December 31, 1998 to the present. As a result of the sale of these products, exposures to the above-referenced chemical have been occurring without adequate warnings. California consumers, through the act of buying, acquiring and utilizing the products, are exposed to the above-referenced Proposition 65 chemical. For example, exposures occur when California citizens use the products when consuming beverages. People likely to be exposed include, but are not limited to, children and adults.

▪ CONSUMER

California *consumers* purchase the products at issue and are exposed to the listed chemical contained in the products. Similarly, men and women in California use the products as a part of their jobs and are, therefore, subject to occupational exposures to the listed chemical. In addition, these products are used by sole proprietors and other persons in settings not covered by the OSH Act. Without proper warnings as to the toxic effects of exposures to the listed chemical in the products, California citizens lack the information necessary to make informed decisions whether to eliminate or reduce the risk of exposure to the toxic chemical from the use of the products.

▪ OCCUPATIONAL

This notice alleges the violation of Proposition 65 with respect to occupational exposure governed by the California State Plan for Occupational Safety and Health. The State Plan incorporates the provisions of Proposition 65, as approved by Federal OSHA on June 6, 1997. This approval specifically placed certain conditions with regard to occupational exposures on Proposition 65, including that it does not apply to the conduct of manufacturers occurring outside the State of California. The approval also provides that an employer may use the means of compliance in the

general hazard communication requirement to comply with Proposition 65. It also requires that supplemental enforcement is subject to the supervision of the California Occupational Safety and Health Administration. Accordingly, any settlement, civil complaint, or substantive court orders in this matter must be submitted to the Attorney General.

Penney Company, Inc. is a retailer of the products at issue. The chemical at issue causes the following types of harm, as follows:
