Greetings:

This office and the Mateel Environmental Justice Foundation (“Mateel”) hereby give you notice that the private businesses listed in the attached service list have been, are, and threaten to be in violation of Cal. Health & Safety Code §25249.6. This office and Mateel are both private enforcers of Proposition 65, both organizations may be reached at the below-listed address and telephone number, I may be considered a “responsible individual” at both organizations, and I may be contacted at the same address and telephone number. The above referenced violations occur when these businesses market ceramic tableware the food contact surfaces of which are coated with lead-containing glazes (such as plates, bowls, mugs, tea cups, and saucers) (collectively hereinafter “leaded ceramic tableware”). Some examples of the products to which this notice pertains are those listed in the attached Product List. Though a specific model or SKU or product number is given as an example, this notice pertains to all variations of the specific type of product of which the named model or pattern is an example. Handling of, contact with, eating or drinking from, and cleaning up broken ceramic tableware exposes people to lead and lead compounds, lead phosphate, lead acetate, and lead subacetate (hereinafter, collectively, “lead”). Lead leaches from the leaded ceramic tableware into the food or beverage stored in, or served from, the tableware. The food or beverage is then consumed and the accompanying lead ingested. These exposures (and resulting violations) occur occupationally, environmentally, and as the result of the sale of consumer products and/or services. In occupational settings, the type of work that is done during which the above-referenced exposures occur is handling the ceramic tableware, cleaning up broken pieces of it, and drinking from mugs, teacups and bowls, such as at catered office parties. These exposures occur via the dermal absorption, inhalation, ingestion, and subcutaneous routes. These violations have occurred every day since at least February 13, 2003, and will continue every day until reasonable warnings are given to those people exposed or until these businesses stop selling leaded ceramic tableware. These violations are alleged for occupational exposures as well as for consumer and environmental exposures. We do not, however, allege occupational exposure violations as to any of these products the listed business makes outside of California, except as to workplaces the business itself maintains in California. Environmental exposure violations occur in every county of the State and occur both on and off the property of the aforementioned private businesses.



CERTIFICATE OF MERIT

I, William Verick, hereby declare: This Certificate of Merit accompanies the attached sixty-day notice(s) in which it is alleged the parties identified in the notices have violated Health and Safety Code section 25249.6 by failing to provide clear and reasonable warnings. I am the attorney for the noticing party. I have consulted with one or more persons with relevant and appropriate experience or expertise who has reviewed facts, studies, or other data regarding the exposure to the listed chemical that is the subject of the action. Based on the information obtained through those consultations, and on all other information in my possession, I believe there is a reasonable and meritorious case for the private action. I understand that "reasonable and meritorious case for the private action" means that the information provides a credible basis that all elements of the plaintiffs' case can be established and the information did not prove that the alleged violator will be able to establish any of the affirmative defenses set forth in the statute. The copy of this Certificate of Merit served on the Attorney General attaches to it factual information sufficient to establish the basis for this certificate, including the information identified in Health and Safety Code section 25249.7(h)(2), i.e., (1) the identity of the person(s) consulted with and relied on by the certifier, and (2) the facts, studies, or other data reviewed by those persons.



This notice alleges the violation of Proposition 65 with respect to occupational exposures governed by the California State Plan for Occupational Safety and Health. The State Plan incorporates the provisions of Proposition 65, as approved by Federal OSHA on June 6, 1997. This approval specifically placed certain conditions on Proposition 65, including that it does not apply to the conduct of manufacturers occurring outside the State of California. The approval also provides that an employer may use the means of compliances in the general hazard communication requirements to comply with Proposition 65. It also requires that supplemental enforcement is subject to the supervision of the California Occupational Safety and Health Administration. Accordingly, any settlement, civil complaint, or substantive court orders in this matter must be submitted to the Attorney General.
