NOTICE OF VIOLATION

California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act

Re: Lead in Jewelry December 27, 2006

This Notice of Violation is provided to you pursuant to and in compliance with California Health and Safety Code Section 25249.7(d).

- For general information regarding the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, see the attached summary provided by the California EPA (copies not provided to public enforcement agencies).
- This Notice of Violation is provided by the Center for Environmental Health ("CEH"), 528 61st Street, Suite A, Oakland, CA 94609, (510) 594-9864. CEH is a nonprofit corporation dedicated to protecting the environment, improving human health and supporting environmentally sound practices. Michael Green is the Executive Director of and a responsible individual within CEH.

Description of Violation:

- The names and addresses of the violators are attached hereto as Exhibit 1.
- The violations have been occurring since at least December 27, 2003 and are continuing to this day.
- This Notice of Violation covers the "warning provision" of Proposition 65, which is found at California Health and Safety Code Section 25249.6.
- The names of the listed chemicals involved in these violations are lead and lead compounds ("Lead"). Exposures to Lead occur from use of the products identified in this notice.
- The specific type of products causing these violations is jewelry. This jewelry is made of and contains Lead. A list of non-exclusive examples of this specific type of products is attached hereto as Exhibit 2.
- Description of Exposure: Use of the products identified in this notice results in human exposures to Lead. Lead is contained in both the metallic and non-metallic parts of the jewelry. For example, the non-metallic cords of bracelets and necklaces contain Lead, as does the pearl coating on imitation pearls and the metallic components such as beads, pendants, clasps, posts and other parts of the jewelry. The route of exposure for the violations is direct ingestion when consumers place the products in their mouths, ingestion via hand to mouth contact after consumers touch or handle the products, and dermal absorption directly through the skin when consumers touch, handle, or wear the products. These exposures occur in homes, workplaces and everywhere else throughout California where these products are worn, handled or used. No clear and reasonable warning is provided with these products regarding the carcinogenic or reproductive hazards of Lead.

Resolution of Noticed Claims:

 Based on the allegations set forth in this Notice, CEH intends to file a citizen enforcement lawsuit unless each of the alleged violators agrees in a binding written instrument to remedy the violations alleged herein by recall of products already sold, warning or reformulation of products in the future, and to pay an appropriate civil penalty based on the factors enumerated in California Health and Safety Code Section 25249.7(b). If any of the alleged violators is interested in resolving this dispute without resort to expensive and time-consuming litigation, please feel free to contact CEH through its counsel identified below. It should be noted that CEH cannot: (1) finalize any settlement until after the 60-day notice period has expired; nor (2) speak for the Attorney General or any District or City Attorney who received CEH's 60-day Notice. Therefore, while reaching an agreement with CEH will resolve its claims, such agreement may not satisfy the public prosecutors.

affirmative defenses set forth in the statute.

identified in Health & Safety Code §25249.7(h)(2), i.e. (1) the identity of the persons consulted

with and relied on by the certifier, and (2) the facts, studies or other data reviewed by those
