



Greetings:

This office and the Mateel Environmental Justice Foundation ("Mateel") give you notice that Cal-June, Inc. has been, is, will be and threatens to be in violation of Cal. Health & Safety Code § 25249.6. Both this office and Mateel are private enforcers of Proposition 65, both may be contacted at the below listed address and telephone number, and I am a responsible individual at both Mateel and this office. The above referenced violations occur when California residents come into contact with life preservers, also known as ring buoys, that are made from plastic that contains lead (hereinafter "leaded plastic ring buoys"). A specific example of the specific types of these products is Jim-Buoy Commercial Ring Buoy -- Type IV P.F.D. Model # JB-24W. Though a specific model is given as an example, this notice pertains to all models, and all variations, of the specific type of leaded plastic ring buoys of which the named model is an example. The plastic these ring buoys are made from contains lead and lead compounds ("lead"), chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects and other reproductive harm. California residents are exposed to lead when they handle and wear these leaded plastic ring buoys. Lead in the plastic is transferred from the plastic to their hands and to other parts of their skin. This lead is then absorbed through the skin, taken into cuts and abrasions, absorbed through mucous membranes, and transferred from the skin to the mouth via oral contact either directly with the plastic, from oral contact with the lead-contaminated skin, and when lead is transferred from contaminated skin to cigarettes and food and the contaminated cigarettes and food are smoked and/or eaten. These lead exposures thus occur via the dermal absorption, subcutaneous, mucus membrane, ingestion and inhalation routes. Cal-June, Inc. did not and does not provide people with clear and reasonable warnings before it exposed Californians to lead. These violations have occurred every day since at least May 10, 2004, and will continue every day until the lead is removed from the plastic used to make these accessories, or until clear and reasonable warnings are given. The above-referenced violations are alleged for occupational exposures as well as for consumer and environmental exposures. We do not, however, allege occupational exposure violations as to any leaded plastic ring buoys made outside of California, except as to workplaces Cal-June Inc. itself maintains in California. Exposures constituting Proposition 65 environmental exposure violations occur both on and off the property of Cal-June Inc.'s business and in each of California's 58 counties.



CERTIFICATE OF MERIT

I, William Verick, hereby declare: This Certificate of Merit accompanies the attached sixty-day notice(s) in which it is alleged the parties identified in the notices have violated Health and Safety Code section 25249.6 by failing to provide clear and reasonable warnings. I am the attorney for the noticing party. I have consulted with one or more persons with relevant and appropriate experience or expertise who has reviewed facts, studies, or other data regarding the exposure to the listed chemical that is the subject of the action. Based on the information obtained through those consultations, and on all other information in my possession, I believe there is a reasonable and meritorious case for the private action. I understand that "reasonable and meritorious case for the private action" means that the information provides a credible basis that all elements of the plaintiffs' case can be established and the information did not prove that the alleged violator will be able to establish any of the affirmative defenses set forth in the statute. The copy of this Certificate of Merit served on the Attorney General attaches to it factual information sufficient to establish the basis for this certificate, including the information identified in Health and Safety Code section 25249.7(h)(2), i.e., (1) the identity of the person(s) consulted with and relied on by the certifier, and (2) the facts, studies, or other data reviewed by those persons.



This notice alleges the violation of Proposition 65 with respect to occupational exposures governed by the California State Plan for Occupational Safety and Health. The State Plan incorporates the provisions of Proposition 65, as approved by Federal OSHA on June 6, 1997. This approval specifically placed certain conditions on Proposition 65, including that it does not apply to the conduct of manufacturers occurring outside the State of California. The approval also provides that an employer may use the means of compliances in the general hazard communication requirements to comply with Proposition 65. It also requires that supplemental enforcement is subject to the supervision of the California Occupational Safety and Health Administration. Accordingly, any settlement, civil complaint, or substantive court orders in this matter must be submitted to the Attorney General.
